Detailed Note on Project

The Optical fiber cables are always laid along the road side due to easy supervision, quick maintenance, and low cost of maintenance. The Applicant does not have to acquire land for this purpose as the road side land belongs to PWD Punjab State. Laying of Cable shall be done on a 0.45cm width of surface land, & up to 1.65 metres of depth and near to the extreme road boundary where alignment of trench will be done in such way that no tree will be required to be cut. The laying of Optical fiber cable along roadside is an agreed policy of the Applicant and Ministry of Surface Transport
