The accompanying notice prepared by the High Commissioner for India regarding the status of senior and junior students at Oxford is published for general information.

**Notice.**

The University of Oxford have recently passed a statute partially ratifying the position of students with Indian qualifications obtaining senior or junior status. The statute has already come into force, but any student entitled to claim the status and the privileges of an Indian junior student under the present regulations may do so until the first day of the Michaelmas term, 1923.

The new statute for senior and junior students at Oxford confers junior status on Indian B.A. or B.Sc. holders, provided that their degree includes the study of English and in addition two of the following languages:—Latin, German, Greek, French, Sanskrit, Pali, Arabic, Persian and Classical Chinese; plus of those languages must be either Latin, Greek, French or German. It is further provided that all junior students must take an Honours School in either the First or Second Divisions of the School of Agriculture and Forestry. In the former, senior students must have studied for three years at an Indian University and have obtained a Degree with First or Second Class Honours. Both the Degree and the University required the approval of the Imperial Council, but it may be taken for granted that the University and the Honours which have been already approved will still be accepted. It is provided that senior students can only obtain the First Degree with Honours and not a pass degree.

It should be noted that as a result of this new statute no senior student will be able to offer Forestry or Agriculture for a degree. A candidate who desires to take either of these subjects should therefore apply for junior (and not senior) status.
