

Diversion of 2.7279 ha of forest land in favour of Gas Authority of India Ltd. (GAIL) for Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra UG pipeline under Bankura (N), Kangsabati (N) and Burdwan Forest Divisions.

Sir,

I am to refer to State Govt. letter 2421-For/O/L/10T-07/2019 dated 24.12.2019 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

- 2. After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change hereby conveys 'Stage-I/in-principle' approval for diversion of 2.7279 ha of forest land in favour of Gas Authority of India Ltd. (GAIL) for Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra UG pipeline under Bankura (N), Kangsabati (N) and Burdwan Forest Divisions, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.
 - (i) Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
 - (ii) Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the user agency.
 - (iii) Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 5.58 ha degraded forest land indentified in Kangsabati (N) Division (1.10 ha), Burdwan Division (3.26 ha) and Bankura (N) Division (1.22 ha) at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
 - (iv) The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and at the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.
 - (v) The C.A. Schemes over 5.58 ha of degraded forest land shall be technically approved by Addl. PCCF (Nodal), West Bengal before Stage-II approval.

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- (vi) The State Govt. shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for 2.7279 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No.566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by Ministry vide letter No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18.09.2003, as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC dated 03.10.2006 and No.5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regard.
- (vii) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Govt. from the user agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- (viii) All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to State CAMPA fund only through (https://parivesh.nic.in/).
- (ix) The user agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department.
- (x) The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- (xi) The pipeline shall be laid down 1.2 meter below the ground as proposed by the State Govt. and after laying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- (xii) The user agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
- (xiii) The layout of plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- (xiv) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- (xv) Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- (xvi) The boundary of the forest land being diverted shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- (xvii) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- (xviii) The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease to be granted in favour of the user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
- (xix) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.

- (xx) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.
- (xxi) Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
- (xxii) The compliance report shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in).
- 3. After receipt of the report on compliance to the conditions stipulated above, from the State Government of West Bengal, final/Stage-II approval for diversion of the said forest land under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 will be issued by this Ministry. Transfer of forest land to user agency should not be effected by the State Government of West Bengal till final/Stage-II approval for its diversion is issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- 4. However, to facilitate speedy execution of projects involving linear diversion, the in-principle approval may be deemed as the working permission for tree felling and commencement of work, if the required funds for CA, NPV and all other compensatory levies specified in the in-principle approval are realized from the user agency, the State Govt. may allow the commencement of work of the linear project in forest land for a period of one year as per Para 11.2 of Chapter-11 of Handbook of Guidelines issued under F.C. Act, 1980 vide Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.

Sir,

I am to refer to State Govt. letter No. 2421-For/O/L/10T-07/2019 dated 24.12.2019, wherein prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change for diversion of 2.7279 ha of forest land in favour of Gas Authority of India Ltd. (GAIL) for Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra UG pipeline under Bankura (N), Kangsabati (N) and Burdwan Forest Divisions, was sought in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After due consideration of the proposal by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, the inprinciple approval for diversion of the said forest land was accorded by Ministry vide this office letter of even number dated 01.01.2020, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. The Nodal Officer of the State Government has furnished compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval and has requested to grant final approval of the proposal.

- 2. In this connection, I am to say that on the basis of the compliance report furnished by the APCCF (Nodal), West Bengal vide their letter No. 1271-FR/O/L/10T-07/2019 dated 22.12.2020 and uploading of the Stage-I compliance report in *Parivesh* web portal on 24.12.2020, *Stage-II/final* approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change is hereby granted under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 2.7279 ha of forest land in favour of Gas Authority of India Ltd. (GAIL) for Jagdishpur-Haldia-Bokaro-Dhamra UG pipeline under Bankura (N), Kangsabati (N) and Burdwan Forest Divisions, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-
- (i) Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
- (ii) Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the user agency.
- (iii) Compensatory afforestation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 5.58 ha degraded forest land indentified in Kangsabati (N) Division (1.10 ha), Burdwan Division (3.26 ha) and Bankura (N) Division (1.22 ha) at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- (iv) The C.A. Schemes over 5.58 ha of degraded forest land technically approved by Addl. PCCF (Nodal), West Bengal shall be implemented by the State Forest Department.

- (v) The user agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department.
- (vi) The pipeline shall be laid down 1.2 meter below the ground as proposed by the State Govt. and after laying down of pipe line the ground will be leveled.
- (vii) The layout of plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- (viii) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- (ix) Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourer or any legal source of alternate fuel.
- (x) The boundary of the forest land being diverted shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- (xi) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- (xii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
- (xiii) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of Govt. of India.

- (xv) Violation of any of these conditions will be dealt as per Para 1.21 (iii) of Chapter-1 of Handbook of Guidelines issued under F.C. Act, 1980 vide Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.
