

JOINT INSPECTION REPORT

Today on 07-04-2021, PMGSY Division Ramnagar officials and Kathua Wildlife Division officials jointly re-inspected the road from Dhar Road Larey to Sumal after the EDS raised by Kathua Wildlife Warden regarding involvement of forest land in the road project. The Length of the road is 3.325 KM and width is 6 m. Thus the total project area falls under protected area (i.e. Wildlife Sanctuary) is 1.995 Ha. The project area under non-protected area (i.e. Outside Wildlife Sanctuary) is NIL.

During joint inspection it has been found that the forest area involved within protected area of the project is 0.525 Ha. Non-forest area involved under protected area is 1.47 Ha. On the road alignment, there is no involvement of trees.

The Detail of Forest Land involved is as under:

1. Forest Land involved from RD 0/600 to 1/050 = 450 meter
 2. Forest Land involved from RD 1/375 to 1/675 = 300 meter
 3. Forest Land involved from RD 1/900 to 2/025 = 125 meter
- Total Forest Land involved in road = 875 meter

Width of Road = 6.00 meter

Total Forest area involved in road = 875 m x 6 m
= 5250 sqm = 0.525 ha
