## **PROJECT NOTE**

We Mr. Dinesh Kollaiah Kargal & family members are the owners of 4.819 Ha. land in G.No. 12 ,26/1/2 & 26/1/3 of village Karade Taluka Shahapur dist. Thane . The land is at about 10 km distance from Shahapur . Presently it's under agricultural use .Though it is within village Karade it is at a distance from Karade gaothan & situated very close to the border of villages Mamnoli & Savroli Bk. There is no existing road within a distance of 2 to 3 km towards Karade gaothan & the area in between is fully covered by agricultural fields . The only available existing road , from where a connectivity to our land can be established , is the Shahapur – Chandroti road .This road is within 500 meters distance from our land. This road passes through villages Savroli Bk & Mamnoli . All the areas between our land & the existing road are forest areas .The Protected forest S. No. 29 of village Karade , Private forest G. No. 213 & 214 of village Savroli and Protected forest S, No. 49 of village Mamnoli are within this tract & there is no non forest area in between the existing road & our lands . Thus forest lands cannot be avoided for construction of approach road to our lands .

As a part of social service , we are proposing Vrudhashram (Old age home) & Goshala in our above areas in village Karade . These projects will be operationalized on non-commercial no profit no loss basis . It will be funded through our self-contributions & voluntary donations . The local as well as distant people are expected to benefit from these projects . The number of visitors to our lands is expected to increase once the project is commenced . Also the approach road is essential during the construction period to facilitate movement of material & labor in our areas . As per the norms of Mumbai metropolitan region for development , the minimum width required for Approach road is 10 meters .

## **Proposed Activities**

Goshala – Go seva, service to the cows has a place of very high importance since the time of vedas. The cows are referred to as Gomata (mother) or Kamdhenu in our Indian culture. Cows play a very important role in conservation of biodiversity, provide resources to natural farming and protection to mother earth. The populations of Deshi local varieties of cows are under pressure & threat of extinction due to advent of hybrid varieties. Providing adequate protection to the deshi varieties of cows is the

need of the day and the main motive of this Goshala project . Milking or non-milking cows which may be stray , abandoned ,old , sick or handicapped will be provided shelter & feed in the Goshala . Efforts will also be made to stabilize & increase the populations of deshi varieties of cows . This project will be funded through family contributions & donations.

Old age Home - More & more people from the young generations are getting settled in metropolitan cities or even abroad in pursuance of job opportunities & future prospects. In most of the situations it's not possible for the elderly parents to shift to the new places with their children & settle in totally different environment . Thus they are forced to live a lonely life facing issues of safety & security . Staying in social isolation often causes depression & consequent illness in them. Most of the elderly people have some physical issues . Mental & physical health deteriorates in old age . Nursing, proper care & medical help is utmost essential for such elderly people. Emotional support is also necessary in this age. In recent past, instances of elderly people being robbed ,beaten or murdered have also been noticed . In present times number of children not taking proper care of their elderly parents is increasing rapidly . Thus providing Old age homes to the elderly with adequate safety, security & care is becoming more important in the present social situation. Old age home is proposed in the above lands with security & safety provisions and dedicated nursing & medical team to take care of the elderly . The project will be funded through contributions from the elderly or their children, self-contributions & donations.
