
**Subject:** Flouride Control Project for remaining villages in Tehsil Beawar for Wildlife clearance (Proposal No. FP/RJ/WATER/20272/2016)- In Principle approval regarding.

Sir,

Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Wildlife Division, Government of India vide letter No. F.No.6-175/2017/WL dated 28.09.2017 has issued a general direction that the "State/ UT Chief Wildlife Wardens would sanction proposals for laying drinking water pipeline and Optical Fiber Cables for telecommunications inside the National Parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries and Tiger Reserves". In pursuance of the said general direction of GOI and approval accorded by SBWL (By Circulation), the Chief Wildlife Warden, Rajasthan hereby grants In-Principle Wildlife Clearance for the project related to laying of safe drinking water pipeline, free of fluoride for villages of Tehsil Beawar. This linear project is located inside core area of Toadgarh-Raoli Wildlife Sanctuary involving diversion of 1.8008 hectare forest land of protected area. The project activity will include digging of 1 meter wide trench in 18008 running meter length within the sanctuary for laying of pipeline of 100 mm diameter (Proposal No:FP/RJ/Water/20272/2016). The In-Principle Wildlife Clearance is issued subject to the following conditions:-

1. 5% of proportional project cost of the project within the sanctuary area should be deposited in RPACS by the user agency for management and protection of wildlife in the state.
2. The user agency will provide at least one outlet at every 2 km from the pipeline to augment water availability for wild animals and birds inhabiting the area in WLS, at suitable places suggested by Dy.CF, Wildlife Rajsamand.

The user agency shall deposit the amount in RPACS and submit an affidavit stating its willingness to comply with condition No.2. Final sanction will be issued after compliance of the above conditions.
