# Report: Construction of New Police Station Building @ Pampa

This report outlines the plans for the construction of a new police station building at Pampa, submitted through the District Police Chief of Pathanamthitta.

Pampa police station opened in the year 2001 as per Government notification Number G.O (Rt) No.668/2001 Home Dated 17.02.2001, sharing border with Perinad, Vechoochira, Moozhiyar police stations in Pathanamthitta and Erumeli police station in Kottayam Dist and Vandiperiyar Police station in Idukki District. The police station jurisdiction includes 4 wards in Perinadu panchayath and 15,000/- peoples are residing in those wards. For the last 4 years 993 FIR were registered in Pampa PS. Average 330 FIR were registered in every year. Pampa Police Station is prominent with the pilgrimage of Sabarimala Sree Ayyappa Swami temple. In 2023 around 56 lakhs devotees were visited in Sabarimala.

Pampa Police Station presently functioning within the Sree Ayyappa Building (Bearing No IX/296), which is under the ownership of the Travancore Devaswom Board. This building is located in Ward IX of the Ranny-Perunadu Grama Panchayath. However, the existing facility lacks the necessary amenities required for the efficient operation of a police station.

The proposed building will be planned to construct 20-cents (0.081-hectare) plot of forest land located at the opposite side of the KSRTC Depot Pamba. The project aims to address the required facilities to accommodate police personnel during the high influx of visitors & devotees especially during the festive seasons. Pampa Police Station holds significant importance due to its proximity to the Sabarimala pilgrimage site, which attracts lakhs of devotees from all the states of India during festive seasons. The role of the new police station is inevitable because of maintaining law and order, maintenance of traffic, ensuring the safety of the pilgrims & crowd management during Mandla-Makara Vilakku and Monthly Pooja season.

This report serves as a comprehensive report for the necessity of the new police station building at Pampa, taking into consideration of various facts.

# Facilities for Police Personnels

A large number of police personnel from different districts of Kerala and even from southern state who are deployed during festive seasons to manage the crowd and to maintain law and order and traffic. It is imperative to construct a new building with ample facilities is highly necessary. The proposed building should provide comfortable accommodation, Meeting Hall, restrooms, dining area, and recreational spaces, to ensure the well-being and mental happiness of the personnel during their duty hours.

# 2. Addressing Natural Disasters8

The proposed location of the police station in a flood-prone and landslide-prone area which necessitates careful consideration of construction techniques and materials. The new building should be designed to withstand potential floods and landslides, ensuring the safety of both personnel and infrastructure.

# 3. Parking Facilities:

Adequate parking facilities are essential to accommodate department vehicles. Vehicles of Superior Officers & Vehicles of police personnel working in the police station, visitors, and administrative staff. A minimum parking area only is included in the new police station building.

# 4. Reception Areas

The proposed new building includes a reception area which is mandatory as per police norms to handle inquiries from the public, manage administrative tasks, and provide a professional front for the police station.

# 5. Safety from Wild Animals?

Considering the possibility of wild animal attacks and the presence of snakes in the area, the new building's design should incorporate measures to prevent such incidents. This could involve creating barriers, using materials that deter animal intrusion, and implementing proper waste disposal practices to minimize attracting wild Animals.

### 6. Functional Rooms

The new police station building should include separate rooms for the Station House Officer (SHO), Principal Sub-Inspector (SI), as well as dedicated spaces for a Crime Wing, file room, Thondy room, interrogation room, and a writer room etc. These rooms will contribute the best performance in the functions of police and are also mandatory as per police norms.

# 7).Lock Up

As per The National Human Rights Commission guidelines to the police department, three separate Lock Ups are mandatory in every police station, hence 3 Lockups are proposed8 one for males, one for females, and one for transgenders.

### 8. Thondy Rooms.

Thondy rooms are mandatory in every police station to keep the Thondy/ MO's involved in a crime.

### 9. Bell of Arms

A well-equipped Bell of Arms is mandatory in every police station to keep Arms and Ammunitions.

### O.Records Room

Separate records room is essential to every police station to keep station records, court records and other relevant records.

# II. CCTNS/COMPUTER Room

Computer and CCTNS rooms are integral wing of the police station. Currently, a significant portion of tasks such as FIR registration, final report preparation, and complaint registrations etc are done through online workspace. Therefore, the room should be adequately equipped to accommodate computers, modems, printers, scanners, and other necessary equipment's.

### 12. Visitors Room

A dedicated visitors' room is crucial for the newly proposed police station in Pampa because during each festival Season. Around fifty to sixty lakh devotees from all over India visit Sabarimala, and approximately twenty lakh people attend the Monthly Pooja Festival, which takes place from February to November every year. These visitors require a dedicated space to wait and lodge their complaints and grievances and includes the space for lactating mothers as well children asper the guideline mentioned by NHRC.

# 13. Rest Room For Senior Officers, SHO, L/O SI, Crime SI

It's important to note that the police station is situated in Ranni Forest Division. Police department has no land or properties in Pampa especially in Perinadu Grama Panchayth except the land of Perinadu Police Station which is 55 Km away from Pampa Police Station . Moreover, there are no barracks or quarters available for the police personnel stationed at the Pampa police station. The current station operates within an old building Dewaswom Board, which by the lacks sufficient restrooms, especially for senior officers and police personnel. Therefore, it's essential to include separate restrooms for Senior officers, the Station House Officer (SHO), Sub-Inspectors (SI), and all police personnel, including women officers in the newly Proposed Building

## 14. Meeting Hall

For the smooth and safe pilgrimage in Sabarimala, every year senior police officers visit Pampa Police Station before the commencement of the festive season. During this visit, they conduct an evaluation meeting by coordinating with various other departments. Therefore, a full-fledged meeting hall is necessary to facilitate these essential discussions and coordination efforts.

# 15. Dining Hall and Kitchen

The Pampa Police Station is situated in Ranni Forest Division, the nearby town is situated 45 km away from the police station. As the police personnels are working in 24 X 7 manner, a dining hall and kitchen are necessary components for the preparation and serving the food to the police personnel working in police station.

# 16. Dormitory

As the police personnels are working in 24 X 7 manner, a separate dormitory is required to the police persons working in police station and other police personnels detailed for special duty during Monthly Pooja and Mandala Makaravilakku Season in Sabarimala.

Mandala Makara Vilakku season which starts from mid half of November and ends in January is the main festival season of Sabarimala Temple, which lasted for 65 days and every Monthly Pooja season the temple will be opened for 5 days.

Mandala Makara Vilakkau Season around 1000/- police personnel were deployed and every Monthly Pooja season around 250 Police Personnel were deployed for duties at Pampa. For catering their basic needs, high priority should be given by the concerned authority to construct a full-fledged Police Station at Pampa

Above all, drainage facilities, water harvesting, and toilet for disabled persons should be included in newly proposed police station. In conclusion, the construction of a new police station building at Pampa is imperative to cater to the needs of the police personnel during the influx of visitors, particularly during Sabarimala's festive seasons The building design must prioritize safety, functional efficiency, and modern facilities to ensure the well-being of both Police personnel and visitors.


As per the report mentioned above around 50 to 60 lakhs devotees were visiting Sabarimala during festive season. During the high influx of the devotees, the chance of stampedes and other Law & Order issues may occur. In order to maintain the Law & Order, Traffic, Crowd Management and the evacuation at the time of any untoward incidence, the police station is inevitable at Pampa. The permanent police station at pampa would help to prevent the wild poaching in some extent.

By submitting the above facts and circumstances, I humbly requested the concerned Forest authority to take a lenient view to provide the proposed land for constructing the new Pampa Police Station. I hereby also submitting the Plan and Sketch of the Proposed Building with this report.




KEY PLAN FOR PAMAPA POLICE STATION, PATHANAMTHITTA




SITE PLAN FOR PAMAPA POLICE STATION, PATHANAMTHITTA

# PROPOSED PLAN FOR PAMPA POLICE STATION, PATHANAMTHITTA.




