

Certificate

This is to certify that, the proposed road from Pigilam-Hastakavery R&B road to Jarlapadu in Balayapalli mandal in Venkatagiri Range is an admitted right of way ie cart track as per Gazette notifications of Chillamanur RF and is existing prior to 1980. The details of rights of way in each RF as per gazette notifications are as fallows:

1) Chillamanur RF, notified under Section 15 of AP Forest Act, 1967 vide GO Ms. No. 981 Forest & Rural Development (Forest-III) Dept. dt. 3-11-1976.

The following cart tracks to a width of 12 feet are admitted as rights of way for men, cattle and vehicles.

"(3) Cart track from Pigilam to Jarlapadu. It enters the forest between station 30 and 31 at a distance of 440 links from station No. 30 and running in a South-Easterly direction for & distance of about 40 chains leaves the forest between stations 56 and 57 at a distance of 1280 links from station No. 56."

In the proposals, the user agency proposed to black top the road on widening the admitted width. Copy of the Section 15 Gazette notification is enclosed.

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Andhra Pradesh Forest Act, 1967 (Act I of 1967), the Governor of Andhra Pradesh hereby declares the forest land described in the schedule below (delimited in the map kept in the office of the Chief Conservator of Forests) to be a reserved forest with effect from the date of publication of this notification in the Andhra Pradesh State Gazette.

Remarks:— I. There are no enclosures admitted within this forest.

II. The following cart track to a width of 12 feet are admitted as right of ways for men, cattle and vehicles.

(1) Cart track from Pakapudi to Kothapaku. It enters the forest between stations 43 and 44 at a distance of 520 links from station No. 43 and running in a South-Easterly direction for a distance of about 20 chains leaves the forest between stations 46 and 47 at a distance of 400 links from station No. 46.

(2) Cart track from Pigidam to Kethangili. It enters the forest between stations 30 and 31 at a distance of 440 links from station No. 30 and running in a North-Easterly direction for a distance of about 70 chains leaves the forest between stations 50 and 51 at a distance of 1,160 links from station No. 51.

(3) Cart track from Pigidam to Jaglapadu. It enters the forest between stations 30 and 31 at a distance of 440 links from station No. 30 and running in a South-Easterly direction for a distance of about 40 chains leaves the forest between stations 56 and 57 at a distance of 1280 links from station No. 56.

West:—Thence the boundary line generally runs in a North East and northerly direction to station No. 1 which is the starting point with the following magnetic bearings and distances.

(4) Cart track from Nidugallu to Karimanugunta. It enters the forest between stations 218 and 219 at a distance of 520 links from station No. 218 and running in a North Easterly direction for a distance of about 80 chains leaves the forest between stations 13 and 14 at a distance of 1720 links from station No. 13.

(5) Cart track from Karimanugunta to Lingaddipalli. It enters the forest between stations 19 and 20 at a distance of 1,000 links from station No. 19 and running in an easterly direction for a distance of about 40 chains leaves the forest between stations 69 and 70 at a distance of 240 links from station No. 69.

(6) Cart track from Kalaganda to Chilamannur. It enters the forest between stations 209 and 210 at a distance 1,400 links and running in a south easterly direction for a distance of about 140 chains leaves the forest between stations 126 and 127 at a distance of 680 links from station No. 126.

(7) Cart track from Chilamannur to Kamakuru. It enters forest between stations 123 and 124 at a distance of 360 links from station No. 123 and running in a Northerly direction for a distance of about 120 chains leaves the forest between stations 77 and 78 at a distance of 160 links from station No. 77.

(8) Cart track from Chillamannur to Katambadu. It enters the forest between station Nos. 119 and 120 at a distance of 680 links from station No. 119 and running in a North-Easterly direction for a distance of about 70 chains leaves the forest between station 94 and 95 at a distance of 920 links from station No. 94.

Note:—An area of 8.00 acres covered by Railway line that passing through the forest has been excluded from the Reservation.
