## Additional Information for the proposed area -

As per the working plan of Jalpaiguri Division for the period 2007 – 08 to 2016 – 17, which was approved by the MoEF, Government of India vide no 13/FCWP/WB-JP dt 14.03.2008, the proposed area is within the limit of the Divisional Forest Officer on behalf of Department of Forest, Government of West Bengal. In the volume I of this plan the Table 1.10 says about the reserved forest under other Department or Directorates and the land are the property of the Forest Department. Other Departments or Directorates have the right of use only.

## Legal position

The district of Jalpaiguri came into an administrative unit on 1st January 1869, by the amalgamation of the Western Duars district with Jalpaiguri Sub-Division of Rangpur. The so-called Western Duars was formed in 1864 from land taken from Bhutan.

The forests dealt with in this plan, before they came under the British rule in 1865, continued to be open to indiscriminate felling and were described as "open forests." The first reservations were made in 1879 according to the Indian Forest Act (Act VII of 1878). Rights were inquired into by the Forest Settlement Officer during the years 1890 to 1896 and revised notification was issued in the year 1895 (Notification No. 3147-For, dated 2.7.1895). The forests have been reserved from unoccupied waste.

A complete statement showing progress of reservation made since 1880 is given below:
