In this context it is submitted that the shortcomings pertains to this Division are attended as directed vide the above referred letter. The point wise reply is detailed as under:-

Sr.	Observations.	Reply.
1.	In reply to point No. 5 linear map showing all components as asked by Gol has not been found uploaded in online part-I of the portal, same may be uploaded stating the number and titled of column against which it is uploaded.	Now has been uploaded in the portal by the user agency.
2.	In reply to point No. 7 the bill of NPV is still not been prepared on current rates, which may be prepared and uploaded accordingly.	The bill of NPV already prepared as per current rate uploaded on the portal by the DCF.
3.	In reply to point No. 9, project approval documents has still not been found uploaded in online portal.	Now has been uploaded in the portal by the user agency.
4.	In reply to point No. 10 & 11 the comments of the DFO concerned may also be provided.	The reply of point No. 10 the UA admitted that all measures of erosion will be taken while preparing of DPR of formation cutting. Protection works will be provided as per site requirements for ecological restoration of adjoining forest land. And point No. 11 The provision of wire crate walls with proper design be adopted to protect natural water streams/nalla and there shall no any damages of natural water steams/nalla.
5.	In Point No. 12, the Gol has asked to provide the guidelines/norms regarding maximum slope in which muck can be dumped, hence necessary guidelines/norms may be provided.	The dumping sites have been selected at suitable places adjoining to road alignment and muck produced during the construction of road shall be dumped at these dumping sites which shall be protected by providing retaining structure of wire crates for which no slope shall be required by the user agency.
