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**ORDER:**

The Hon'ble Chief Minister, during the Collectors' Conference held on 13.12.2013, made an announcement that "Investigation works will be taken up for providing Combined Water Supply Scheme(CWSS) to 135 rural habitations in Vaiyampatty and Marungapuri Unions in Tiruchirappalli District".

2) Accordingly, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has prepared a Detailed Project Report for providing "CWSS to 135 Rural Habitations in Vaiyampatty and Marungapuri Unions in Tiruchirappalli District utilizing the bulk provision made in the proposed Combined Water Supply Scheme to Natham, Nilakottai, Ammaiyanackanur Town Panchayats and 1276 rural habitations in Dindigul District with bulk provision to Gandhigram University, with River Cauvery as source at a cost of Rs.46.32 Crore to install and Rs.93.90 lakh to maintain annually.

4) The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board in the letter first read above has informed that the Regional Scientific Source Finding Committee and the Regional Technical Committee have cleared the above project. The State Level Technical Committee has also cleared the proposal and recommended the proposal to Board for recommending to the Empowered Committee for getting administrative approval. Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board Schedule of Rates for the year 2014-15 is adopted for this scheme. The proportionate cost of the above Combined Water Supply Scheme is included in the main scheme i.e., "Combined Water Supply Scheme to Natham, Nilakottai, Ammaiyanaickanur Town Panchayats and 1276 rural habitations in 11 Unions with bulk provision to Keeranur, Neikkaranpatti Town Panchayats and 354 rural habitations in Palani, Thoppampatti Union of Dindigul District."

5) The Board in its Resolution No.2.10 dated 28.11.2014 resolved to recommend to Empowered Committee, for according Administrative Approval to the proposal for providing "Combined Water Supply Scheme to 135 Rural Habitations in Vaiyampatty and Marungapuri Unions in Tiruchirappali District" with River Cauvery as source at a cost of Rs.46.32 Crore to install and Rs.93.90 lakh to maintain annually and to implement the scheme with 100% Grant under MNP / NRDWP-SMS. Based on the recommendation of Board, the Empowered Committee has approved the proposal.

6) The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has therefore requested to accord Administrative Sanction for providing "Combined Water Supply Scheme to 135 Rural Habitations in Vaiyampatty and Marungapuri Unions in Tiruchirappali District utilizing the bulk provision made in the proposed "Combined Water Supply Scheme to Natham, Nilakottai, Ammaiyanaickanur Town Panchayats and 1276 rural habitations in Dindigul District with bulk provision to Gandhigram University, with River Cauvery as source" at a cost of Rs.46.32 Crore to install and Rs.93.90 lakh to maintain annually and to implement the scheme with 100% Grant under MNP / NRDWP-SMS.

7) Due to paucity of funds in NRDWP/SMS/MNP, the above scheme was posed for funding under NABARD. In the letter second read above, NABARD among others, has sanctioned RIDF loan in the following pattern:-
