

Subject: Diversion of 275.16 ha. (Instead of 109.64ha.) forest land (211.06 ha. Protected forest and 64.10 ha. PLPA area) excluding delisted area(58.75 ha) out of 333.91 ha of total land for Reservoir of Shahpurkandi Dam Project in Tehsil Dhar Kalan Forest Division and district Pathankot.

With reference to the letter No. 8-15/2019-FC dated 17.10.2019 as received from DIG of Forests, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (Forest conservation branch), Government of India on the subject cited above, the reply to the observations is as follows:

4	Combined/ revised proposal including submergence area (618.53 ha) of Jammu & Kashmir also needs to be included.	It is submitted that case for the forest clearance has already been taken up with J&K forest department & it will be submitted separately.
