

1. Description of C.A. Site

a) Soil Type	Sandy Loam

2. Plantation Model:

Compensatory afforestation over an area of 3.625 Ha. of degraded forest land is proposed to be raised. The area selected for this purpose is Bali Tirshi Forests (65/U), Beat Gangera which is a degraded forest area and has been proposed for CA. Presently the area supports scattered Chir (*Pinus roxburghii*) and other broadleaved trees. Whole of the plantation of 3.625 ha will be raised in a one Patch. The area identified for plantation has also been shown on the attached map. The species to be planted will be mainly Chir and some local Mixed Broad leaved species. Total financial outlay for compensatory plantation scheme is Rs.5,01,654/-. The monitoring will be done as per existing monitoring mechanism in the Forest Department at present and also as per G.O.I instructions.
