Sir,

With reference to the subject cited above, the proposal No. under reference and joint verification report of Karbi Anglong East Division vide letter No. B/KAE/NHIDCL/NOC/2021-22/1478-83 dated 17/08/2021, I am herewith submitting the details of the field verification report conducted jointly by the authority of Nodal Branch (HoFF, Assam), Officials of the Dokmoka Range (Karbi Anglong East Division), Dokmoka, authorities of the NHIDCL and DPR consultant on 10.01.2022 in presence of Officials of the Revenue Department (Phuloni Circle). The verification report have been prepared by compiling data from the DPR consultant, Range Office, Phuloni Circle and the boundary map of Sildharampur Reserve Forest as provided by the Dokmoka Range Office. It is observed that some parts of the proposed road mentioned as cadastral area in the JV report are found to be inside Sildharampur RF. These area are mainly inhabited by local tribal groups for many generations holding both Periodic Patta and Annual Patta thus paying taxes to the Revenue Department of Karb Anglong East Autonomous Council. During the field survey conducted to carry out the process of JV it was found that all the settlements found inside the Sildharampur RF are holding patta details which has caused some confusion among the authorities of Forest Department, Revenue Department and User Agency thus erroneously declaring these forest area as cadastral region. Moreover, earlier the exact area of notified deforested area of Sildharampur RF was also not clear and it is only after this field investigation that has made the extent of deforested area clearer to all the concerned authorities and this has also contributed towards erroneously declaring some forest part as cadastral area. It is important to note here that now the agreed and verified deforested area as per the notification on the ground is not a part of the Sildharampur RF and therefore, the proposed road has to consider all the areas as forest area as per the boundary map of Sildharampur RF as made available and verified by Dokmoka Range Office.
