Essential Details Sought by DFO:

1. Compensatory Afforestation (CA) Site Suitability certificate by the DFO uploaded.
2. The DFO has stated vegetation density as 4 (i.e.400%) and Eco class 4 in part - 2. The earlier figure may be corrected and the latter be elaborated on the basis of present forest type.: This is not concern of the user agency.
3. Total temporary employment as per online application is 185 only whereas the total employment generation as mentioned in CBA is different.: The figures Corrected in the Cost Benefit Analysis.
4. Project cost mentioned in Part – I and the same used in Cost Benefit Analysis are different.: The Cost Benefit Analysis Corrected and uploaded.
5. Cost Benefit Analysis is apparently not correct.: Corrected and uploaded.
6. The KML of alternative route of transmission Line along with Land type Characterization uploaded.
7. The comments of the State Forest Department, Nodal officer (FC) as well as concern DFO regarding actual tree felling, no. of trees proposed for trimming for the project are not submitted. Details in this regard may be uploaded.: This is not concern of the user agency.
8. Undertaking/Comments of the User Agency regarding the implementation of Site-Specific Wildlife Management Plan.: Undertaking by User Agency Uploaded.
9. As the proposed route is crossing the highway, the NOC from NHAI/RCD/PWD is mandatory before issuance of Stage – I Approval.: NOC issued from RCD and uploaded.
10. As per DSS analysis, it appears that proposed forest land for diversion has been violated by user agency by way of starting the project related work in forest area ,If yes then it must be taken into cognizance at the earliest and a complete action taken report against the perpetrators in this regard may be uploaded/submitted to this office along with the explanation why forest department could not assess the violation while processing the application.: This is not concern of the user agency.
