Project stretch falls in the State of Delhi and Faridabad, which is situated in the Northern part of India. Delhi, officially the National Capital Territory of Delhi (NCT), is a city and a Union Territory of India. It is bordered by Haryana on three sides and by Uttar Pradesh to the east. The NCT covers an area of 1,484 Km². It is connected to other parts of India by five National Highways: NH 44, NH 19 (Old NH 2), NH 75 (Old NH 48), NH 9 & NH 24 and some important Pillars of Delhi's Road Infrastructures like - Inner Ring Road, Outer Ring Road, Delhi Noida Direct flyover (DND), Delhi Gurugram Expressway, Delhi Faridabad skyway etc.

The proposed road would act as the prime artery for the economic flow to this region.
