Dear Sir,

This is in reference to the above subject we would like to inform you that **M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd**, having its registered office No: 222, 3rd Floor, Makers Chamber IV, Nariman Point, Mumbai-400021, with Department of Telecommunications (DOT) as Infrastructure Provider category I (IP-I) vide registration certificate No: 370/2011 dated 23rd June 2011 to establish and maintain the assets such as Dark Fibers, Right of way, Duct space & Tower and the copy of same is enclosed herewith.

We are planning to lay optical fiber cable by Manual trenchin Method for connecting our Intercity routes Along NH-234 (BC Cross Jn (Belthangadi-Belur) section from **KM 19.80 to 86.20 KM** -Total for a Length of 66.40 Kms in the state of Karnataka By Manual Trenching Method.

With reference to your letter cited above we have made corrections as described below.

1)The ROW distances shown in the drawing are seems to be arbitrary and not as per actual/site conditions.

Our comment:We have send revised drawings after doing actual survey at site,kindly we request you to inspect our drawings along with our Engineer to check actual distances.

2)The intention of marking ROW less than 15m from centre of the road in the drawing all along the alignment from KM19.80 to 86.20, is to claim relaxation purposefully,and to propose the cable trench all along the 'road shoulder'for" easiness of your work" seems to be not genuine one.

Our comment : If 15 M Row is available surely we will lay our cable at the edge of the Boundary and we don't want to lay near the shoulder which will damage our cable.Kindly guide us where we have to lay cable so that we will follow the same.

3)Permission from Forest Department may be obtained and enclosed in the report for laying the cable in Charmady Ghat Section,where the land beyond the road shoulder belongs to Forest Department(Reserved Forest Area).Deep trenching is not allowed in Charmady Ghat stretch and alternate safe arrangement may be looked into.

Our Comment: We will obtain forest permission after obtaining permission from your kind office ,we will not do any deep trenching in Charmady Ghat we will be laying by encasing G.I.pipe.

4)The cables should ordinarily run along ROW or ata minimum distance of 15 M from the centre line of the nearest carriageway as per the Ministry's circular No.NH-III/P/66/76 dated:20-08-1982.

Our Comment:We will lay cables as per the Guidelines mentioned above.

5)A table showing distance of ROW, Cable trench, carriageway edge from centre line of road with a remark for relaxation if any, at every 100M interval may be submitted.

Our Comment: We are enclosing all the details mentioned above along with this letter.

The work will be carried out as per laid down standard Condition & Guidelines of NH for laying the OFC Cable.

We are enclosing herewith the requisite documents for the permissions to lay the Optical Fiber Cable (OFC).

You are requested to kindly grant us the permission at the earliest as we intend to take up the job immediately.
