- A proposal has been received by this office from Vindhya Telelinks Ltd., Jammu, for diversion (under FCA, 1980) of 0.97 Ha of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The subject envisages the use of forest land for Laying of underground Optical Fiber Cable on Mahedi-Thall- Bhullari. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on 17.04.2022. On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the User Agency is a forest land measuring, 0.97 ha located in Ishu Reserve Forest in Compartment No. 25b/Blr & Brotha Reserve Forest in 78/Bni of Malhar Range. The requirement of forest land as proposed by the User Agency in Col. 2 of Part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
