

The site for compensaoty Afforestation has been selected in the non forest land of Baunsen village under Rengali Tahasil of Sambalpur District over an area of 11 ha. against the proposed project of diversion of 8.361 ha. coming under Sambalpur Forest Division. There is only one patch of land identified for CA and it is continuous with the reserve forest at one side. The private patta land inside the patch has been excluded from the CA land identified.
(ii)	Map showing non-forest area/ degraded forest area identified for compensatory afforestation and adjoining forest boundaries.	DGPS maps and map on village sheet showing non-forest area identified for C.A and adjoining forest boundaries have been prepared annexed in the diversion proposal.
(iii)	Detailed compensatory scheme including species to be planted, implementing agency, time schedule, cost structure, etc.	The detailed compensatory scheme is of ANR gap plantation with 800 plants/ha with the provision of barbed wire fencing, special SMC measures and incentive to the VSS has been prepared following the standard cost norm prescribed by the P.C.C.F, Odisha at the current wage rate @Rs.280/mandays with 10 year maintenance. It is proposed to plant to local indigenous species like <i>Syzizium cumini</i> (Jamu), <i>Adina cardifolia</i> (Kuruma), <i>Anogeissus latifolia</i> (Dhaura), <i>Accacia catechu</i> (Khair), <i>Dalbergia latifolia</i> (Pahadi sishoo), <i>Dalbergia sissoo</i> (Sissoo), <i>Azadirachta indica</i> (Neem), <i>Gmelina arborea</i> (Gambar), <i>Terminalia belerica</i>

		(Bahada), <i>Terminalia chebula</i> (Harida), <i>Pongamia pinnata</i> (Karanja), <i>Emblica officinalis</i> (Amla).
(iv)	Total financial outlay for compensatory afforestation scheme.	The financial outlay for the compensatory Afforestation including escalation cost 20% at current wage rate of Rs.280/mandays is proposed to Rs.29,10,693/-.
