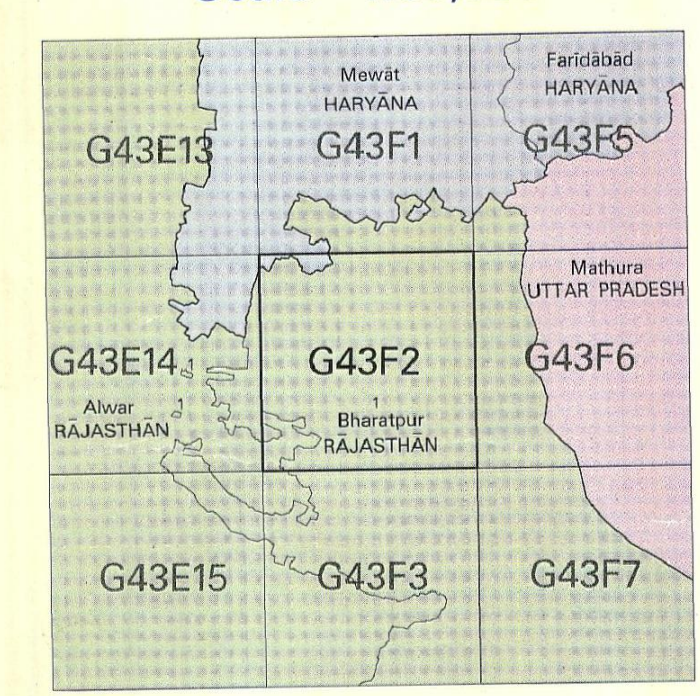

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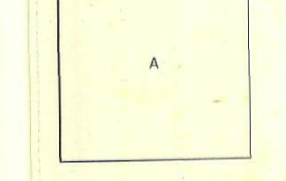
CONVENTIONAL SYMBOLS

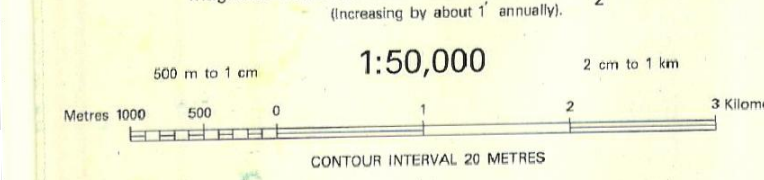
NOTES :-

Heights are in metres and above Indian mean sea level.
Contours are approximate.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to February.
Unmetalled road and cart-track in this sheet are generally motorable. Permission to use these along canal is required from the irrigation authorities.
Limits of cultivation are variable and dependent on rainfall.
A relative height, e.g., 3, marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
A relative height, e.g., 5, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
The kilometre stone numbers along roads are shown in slant type, e.g., 5, whereas mile stone numbers along the Kaimur road are shown in up-right type, e.g., 5.

COMPILATION INDEX



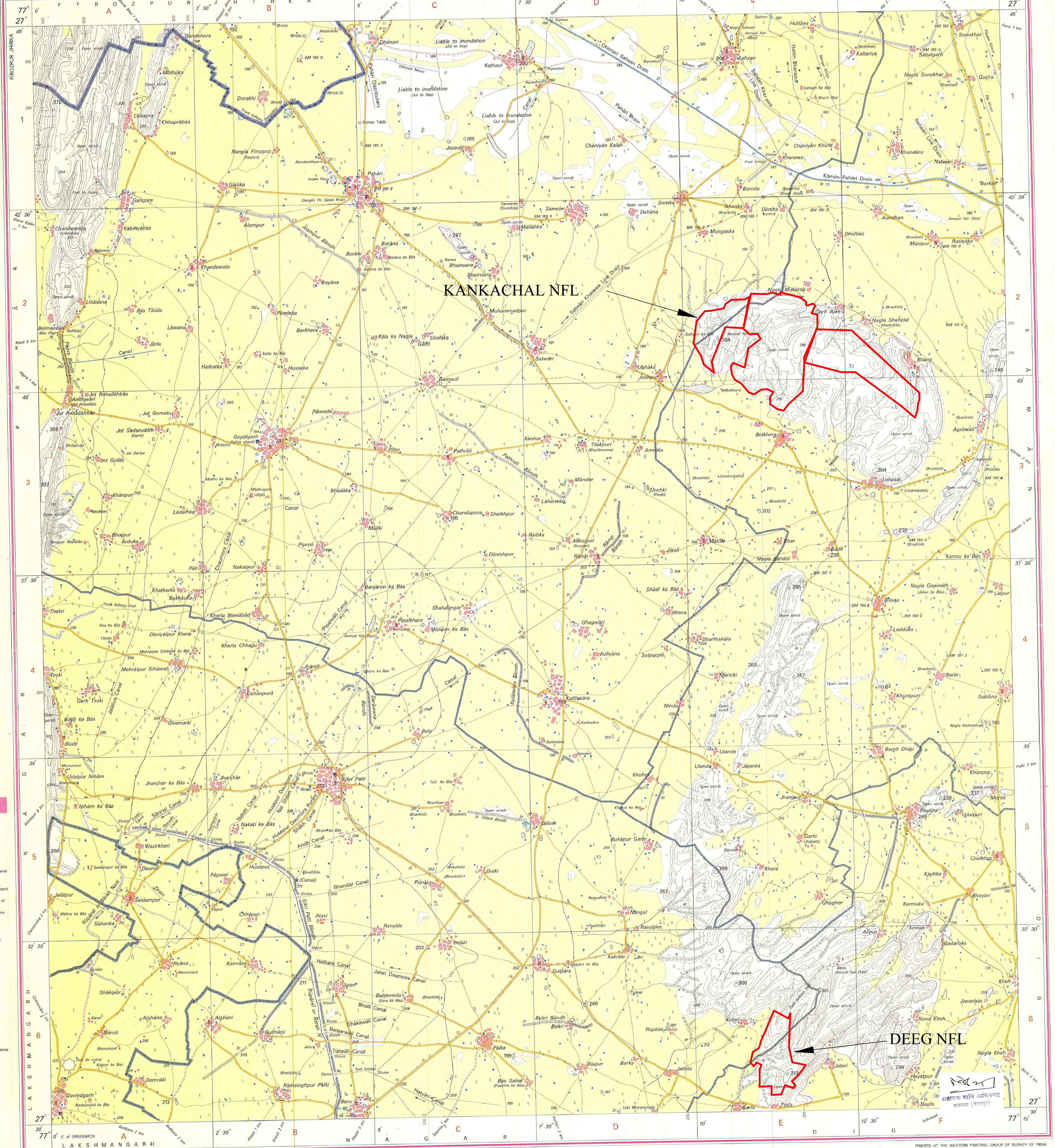
Projection - UTM Datum - WGS 84
