

13. Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance or otherwise of the proposal with reasons:

The proposed is recommended on the grounds of making the State of Sikkim self reliant and providing sufficient employment opportunity to the people of Sikkim. The Construction of RCR from Kabirthing to Ratomatey School in West District by Rural Management Development Department, West for diversion of 0.2987 ha. of forestland involved the barest minimum of forest land. This diversion of forest land is recommended for approval subject to conditions laid by the State and Central Government and removal of minimum number of tree and poles wherever found to be absolutely unavoidable.
