SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF (For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Construction Division -3 PWD Barabanki for construction of culvert and approach road under Forest Conservation Act, 1980 of 0.285 Ha. of forest land for non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for construction and culvert and approach road.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated 28.05.2013.

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a protected forest measuring 0.285 Ha.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col.2 part-1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
