Sub: - DPRE, PIU, KB Asifabad – PMGSY – Forest Clearance – **Diversion of 2.942 ha of forest land for formation of BT road from ZP road 27/9 to Gundala via Doddiguda of Tiryani Mandal of Ryali RF in Asifabad Division in KB Asifabad District in favour of District Panchayath Raj Engineer, PIU, Komrambheem Asifabad District (Proposal No. FP/TG/ROAD/124336/2021)** – EDS raised by the IRO, Hyderabad, GOI – submission of EDS data – request to take necessary action – reg.

Ref: - EDS Raised by IRO, Hyderabad, GOI, Lr.No. F.No 4-TSB215/2021-HYD, Dt:30-05-2023.

Through the reference cited above, the IRO, Hyderabad, GOI has raised an EDS duly stating the following shortcomings for the above subjected work as follows:

1. The extent of forest land proposed for diversion is shown as 4.361 ha at S1.B and as 2.942 ha at S1.C of Part-I filled by the User agency in Parivesh portal, whereas the area is shown as 2.9428 in Part-II filled by the the SFD in Parivesh portal. Therefore, the are details need to be corrected in all relevant fields on Parivesh by the State Government and the User Agency.
2. Design and Cross-section of the road proposed to be constructed may be submitted by the User Agency.
3. The user agency may explore the possibility of constructing all weather road instead of BT road as the entire alignment is located in the Tiger habitat and the human population is very less in the area.

In connection to the above I am here with submitting the EDS data point wise respectively as follows:

1. The Proposal is prepared with 8m width as per site condition for an extent of 4.361 ha forest land as against 2.9428 ha forest land with 6m width recommended by forest department. Hence it is requested to consider 8m width for the proposal for 4.361 ha of forest land extent.
2. Design and Cross Section enclosed here with.
3. All Possibilities are explored while preparation of proposals and as per the PMGSY guidelines it is need to construct BT Road, hence please consider for BT Road.

This is submitted for information and to take further necessary action.

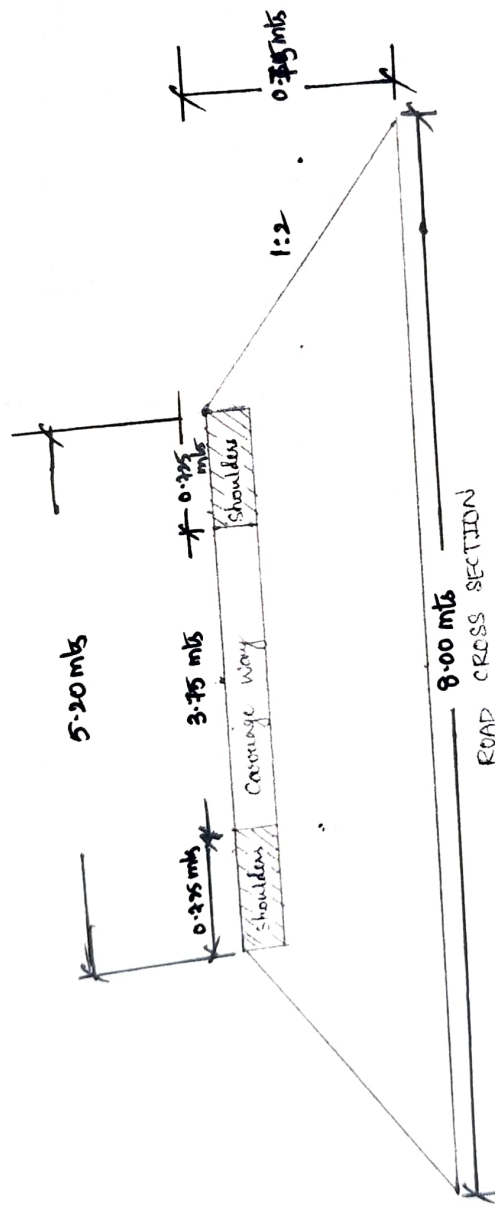
