In pursuance of the proposal by the Deputy Commissioner, Chickamagalur, the Government has ordered on 25-01-2019 to release the said 648.38 acres of land to the Forest Department from Land Bank, following which the Deputy Commissioner, Chickamagalur, in his Order No. M4: LND:CR:195:2007-08, dated 29-03-2019 has transferred 200 acres with survey no. 38, 320.30 acres with survey no. 39, 5 acres with survey no. 40, 57.33 acres with survey no. 45, 43.14 acres with survey no. 46 and 22.01 acres with survey no. 49 in Kesuvinamane village - a total of 648.38 acres to Forest Department. In lieu of 230 acres Reserve Forest granted on lease for the establishment of Kuvempu University, Revenue Department has transferred 384.56 hectares (950.25 acres) of Govt land to Forest Department for afforestation
