The comments of Chief Wild life Warden as per EDS at Point No. (iii) of IRO Jammu need to be uploaded at part -II	As per Final Notification of Eco sensitive zone of KHANP (Kishtwar High Altitude National Park) issued under S.O No 4262 Dt. 13.10.221 by MoEF & CC, Govt of India, the area proposed to be diverted does not falls in Eco sensitive zone of KHANP. Moreover in Forest proposal No. FP/JK/ROADS/51198/2020 Dt. 16.10.2020, The area to be diverted is 5.6 Km from KHANP whereas in this proposal the aerial distance of the proposed land to be diverted is 9.1 Km. So the proposed area to be diverted neither falls neither in KHANP nor in Eco sensitive zone of KHANP. Copy of Final Notification uploaded in additional documents and comments of Chief Wild life Warden in Forest proposal No. FP/JK/ROADS/51198/2020 Dt. 16.10.2020 uploaded in additional documents as well.
