Specific recommendations of the DCF for acceptance of otherwise of the proposal with reasons.

M/s Reliance Jio Infocomm Limited proposes to lay underground Optical Fiber Cable (OFC) from Macherla to Vijayapuri South in Palnadu District of Andhra Pradesh to extend 4G Communication facilities to multiple villages en route and a part of the proposed path passes through Rajiv Gandhi Wildlife Sanctuary (Nagarjuna Sagar-Srisailam Tiger Reserve). Once the Project is completed, digital communication services like communication. Education. Entertainment, Healthcare and financial services will be provided to the local Panchayats, Schools, Hospitals, General Public and various Government Departments like Forest, Irrigation, Police and Revenue.

Felling of aforesaid trees will have a minimal impact on wildlife habitat in terms of disturbance to wildlife and fragmentation of habitat

As per the justification furnished by the User Agency, there is no alternate path available to avoid Forest area and proposed area is the only way to extend the 4G Communications facilities to multiple villages en route the area requested for laying of the Optical Fiber Cable is the bare minimum considering the requirements considering the safety of the cables so laid. Since the telecommunication cables also carry the communication from the Government offices, Defense& Strategic establishments, and from different industrial organizations apart from the public, for the safety and confidentiality of the conversation so made it is not advisable to lay such User

Important cables on the private land belonging to different parties. Hence the Agency stated that there is no other alternative except proposing the diversion of 0.15 ha of forest land.

Hence recommended of this project for digital communication services like communication, Education, Entertainment, Healthcare and financial services will be provided to the local Panchayats, Schools, Hospitals, General Public and various Government Departments like Forest, Irrigation, Police and Revenue.
