1	Project Details:	The Total length of the road from Jeedichetlapalem R&B Road to Kunkuduchetlapalem in Chinaganjam Mandal is 2.170 km with Earthen surface.
1	Short narrative of the proposals and project scheme for which land is required	The proposed Road Connects Kunkuduchetlapalem Village in Chianganjam Mandal which links to Jeedichetlapalem and Motupalli of Chinaganjam Mandal. The proposed road serves a total population of nearly 800. The basic Occupation of this village is fishing and agricultural labour. Already there is Earthen road in forest land from Km 0/0+80 to 1/8+30. The work Road from Jeedichetlapalem R&B Road to Kunkuduchetlapalem was Administratively Sanctioned under NCRMP Ph-II for Rs.331.00 Lakhs Vide GORT No.171 Dt.09.08.2012 of Revenue (Disaster management -III) Department. The work is technically sanctioned for Rs.331.00 lakhs assignedTSR No: /2011- 2012, Dt.13.1.2012 by the Engineer - in-Chief, PR, Hyderabad. The Total length of the road is 2.170 km. The reach from Km 0/0 to 1/8+17.i.e. to a length of 1817 Rm is falling in Motupalli Reserve forest area. The extent of land for which permission required from competent authority is about 0.99935 Ha. Hence forest clearance is needed in the reach from Km 0/0 to 1/8+17 for widening and upgradation of existing Earthen road to BT Standards.
