No. II(2)/EFR/3901/89.—In exercise of the powers conferred by section 16 of the Tamil Nadu Forest Act, 1882 (Tamil Nadu Act V of 1882) the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby declares the area, the boundaries of which are specified in the schedule below as reserved forest with effect on and from 12th January 1990.

Bit I (Area 2.05.5 Hectares—)

West and North.—Starting from the North-Western corner of S.No. 57 of No. 23 Singiripalli village on the inter-State boundary between Tamil Nadu and Karnataka the boundary runs generally towards East and reaches North west corner of S.No. 1-5 of 23. Singiripalli village of Krishnagiri Taluk.

South.—Thence the boundary runs towards West along the Northern sides of S. No. 92, 87 and 86 and reaches the south East corner of S. No. 77 all of 40, Konganapalli village.

West.—Thence the boundary runs towards North along Eastern sides of S. Nos. 77 and 76 all of No. 40 Konganapalli village and reaches the starting point.

Bit-V Area 24.42.5 Hectares)—

North and East.—Starting from the trijunction point of S. No. 141, 17 and 143, the boundary runs along the Western sides of S. Nos. 17, 140, 139, and 132 all of No. 42, Sigaramaganapalli village and reaches the Interstate boundary between Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh.

South.—Thence the boundary runs towards South West along the Interstate boundary between Tamil Nadu and Andhra Pradesh and reaches S. No. 146 of No. 42 Sigaramaganapalli village of Krishnagiri Taluk on the interstate boundary.

West.—Thence the boundary runs generally towards North along Eastern side S. No. 146, 144, 65, 3, 2 Southern and Eastern sides of S. No. 142 and 141 all of No. 42, Sigaramaganapalli village of Krishnagiri Taluk and reaches the starting point.

Bit-VI (Area 1.48.5. Hectares)—

North and East.—Starting from the trijunction point of S. No. 311, 310/1 and 309 of No. 28. Kathiripalli village the boundary generally, runs towards East along Southern and Western sides of S. No. 309 Western sides of S. No. 310/3 and reaches the trijunction of S. No. 310/1, 310/3 and 314 of No. 28 Kathiripalli village.

South.—Thence the boundary runs towards Western side along the Eastern, Northern, Western sides of S. No. 310/2 and reaches the trijunction point of S. No. 310/1, 310/2, 311 and 314 of No. 28, Kathiripalli village.

West.—Thence the boundary runs towards North along the Eastern side of S. No. 311 of 28, Kathiripalli village and reaches the starting point.

Bit-VII (Area 101.83.0 Hectares)—

Dasiripalli village and S.No. 252/1 of No. 36. Naduvanapalli village of Krishnagiri taluk.

South.—Thence the boundary runs towards West along Northern side of S.No. 57/1 of No. 35 Dasiripalli village and reaches the village trijunction of 35. Dasiripalli, 36. Naduvanapalli and No. 28. Kathiripalli village all of Krishnagiri taluk.

West.—Thence the boundary runs towards North along the Eastern side of S.No. 314 of No. 28, Kathiripalli village, Eastern sides of S.No. 253 Eastern and Northern sides of S.Nos. 254 and 255 all of No. 36. Naduvanapalli village and reaches the starting point.

LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT DEPARTMENT.

DELEGATION OF FINANCIAL POWERS TO PRINCIPALS OF INDUSTRIAL TRAINING INSTITUTES.

(G.O. Ms. No. 1164, Labour and Employment, 20th June 1989.)

No. II (2)/LE/3904/89.—In the G.O. Ms. No. 1123, Labour and Employment, dated 2nd June 1982, orders were issued permitting the Principals of Industrial Training Institutes to purchase any article under consumable stores upto Rs. 20, at a time and upto Rs. 100 in a month required in connection with Training Programme, Special Occasions like Trade Test, etc., without calling for tenders/quotations from the dealer.

2. Now the Director of Employment and Training has reported that the Principals of the Industrial Training Institutes have represented difficulties to procure their immediate requirements of consumable items by utilising the above purchase powers and requested its revision. The Director of Employment and Training has therefore recommended that the financial power of Principals of Industrial Training Institutes may be enhanced from Rs. 20 to Rs. 50 at a time is urgent nature and upto Rs. 500 per month without calling for tenders/quotations from the dealer. He has also requested that the principals of Industrial Training Institutes may be delegated to procure consumable items upto a sum of Rs. 200 at a time in special occasions take the trade tests, etc.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Employment and Training and they direct that the monetary limit of Rs. 204 ordered in the G.O. Ms. No. 1123, Labour and Employment, dated 2nd June 1982, be enhanced to Rs. 50 at a time and the overall ceiling fixed for a month is increased from Rs. 100 to Rs. 300.

And whereas Government is of the opinion that Safety Officers should be employed such factories for the safety of the persons employed therein.
