Sub:- Issuance of FRA certificate for diversion of 59600 sqm of forest land for construction of approach road from T-14 to Adit T14 with one dumping yard, on (USBRL PROJECT).


In compliance with the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribe and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain exemption /relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 59600 sqm of forest land is proposed to be diverted in favour of Northern Railway required for the construction of approach road from T-14 to Adit T14 with one dumping yard, on (USBRL PROJECT).

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 59600 sqm of forest area proposed for road with one dumping yard. As per MoEF letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.), dated: 5th February 2013 for linear projects like construction of roads, there is no requirement of resolution (meeting/consent) of Gram Sabha of that area of forest land, use of which is proposed to be diverted. Hence, no such records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), and the District Level Committee are enclosed.
- (b) Divisional Forest Officer, Forest Division Ramban vide his No.RFD/GI/20-21/5693-96 dated 02.03.2021 has communicated that no recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups (PTG) and Pre Agriculture Communities (PAC) shall be affected in case above mentioned quantum of forest land is diverted for proposed non forest use i.e. the construction of approach road from T-14 to Adit T14 with one dumping yard, on USBRL PROJECT.

Hence Forest Rights Act certificate is issued for forest land measuring 59600 sqm required for above mentioned Northern Railways project.
