In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF), Government of India's letter No.119/98-FC (pt.) dated 3rd August 2009 where in the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 where in MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 4,399 Hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Executive Engineer (R&B) NH Division, Mancherial for "Widening to two/four lane with paved shoulder from km 180/600 to 223/000 on NH-63 Nizamabad - Jagadalpur road on EPC mode under NH(O) in the state of Telangana" in Mancherial District falls within jurisdiction of Bheemaram Villages in Bheemaram tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 4,399 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure to annexure
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Grama Sabhas have given their consent to it;
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized right of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-agricultural communities.
