# Vattambakkam Extension No. 1.

## Notification.

His Excellency the Governor in Council is pleased to declare, under the provisions of section 16 of the Madras Forest Act (V of 1882), that, from the 15th January 1899, the area, the boundaries of which are set forth in the schedule appended to this notification, shall be constituted "reserved forest".

Chingleput. | Conjeeveram (Now Spr.Tk.) | Mattur, Vattambakkam & Panapakkam. | Vattambakkam Extension No. 1. | North.- Starting from the south-east corner of survey No. 507, a straight line to the south-east corner of survey No. 517-A-2 both of Mattur village; thence a straight line to the south-east corner of survey No. 146; and thence another straight line to a cairn at an angle on the western boundary of Vattambakkam reserved forest, one and a half chains east of the south-west corner of survey No. 129, all of Panapakkam village. |

East.- From the last mentioned point along the boundary of the said Vattambakkam reserved forest up to the tri-junction stone of Vattambakkam and Mattur villages and Oragadam shrotriem.

South.- From the last-mentioned point along the boundary between Mattur village and Oragadam shrotriem north-west wards up to the offset stone half a chain south of the Sivaram-Vandalur road.

West.- From the last-mentioned point along the said village boundary up to the south-east corner of survey No. 493, thence the east limits of survey Nos. 493 and 516, south and east limits of survey No. 515 and east limit of survey No. 508, (all of Mattur village) to the starting point.

Remarks.-1. The undermentioned Local Fund roads each with a margin of twenty-two yards from the centre of the same on either side of it will be demarcated out free from reservation and be retained as enclosures:-

1. Local Fund road from Sivaram to Vandalur. It enters the reserve about two chains south-east of the south-east corner of survey No. 493 of Mattur, runs north-east for about six and a half furlongs and quits it about a furlong and quits it about a furlong south-west of the south-west corner of survey No. 129 (Periya eri) of Panapakkam.

2. Local Fund road branching from the above road item 1 (i) to Panapakkam. It branches north-west of the north-west corner of Chinna kolam runs north-east for about one and a half furlongs and quits the reserve about half a furlong south-west of the south-east corner of survey No. 129 (Periya eri) of Panapakkam.

17. Right of way for men, cattle and carts each to a width of twelve feet over the undermentioned cart-tracks is admitted:-



1. Cart-track branching from the local fund road in item I (1) to Panapakkam. It branches about half a furlong east by north of the south-east corner of survey No. 147, run north for about half a furlong and quits the reserve at the south-east corner of survey No. 146 both of Panapakkam.

2) Cart-track branching from the Local Fund road in Item I (1) Panapakkam. It branches about five chains south-west of the point, where the road meets the old reserve boundary, runs east for about quarter of a furlong and quits the reserve about one and a quarter furlongs south-west of the south-west corner of survey No. 129 (Periya eri) of Panapakkam.

III. Right to the use by ploughing and grazing cattle for drinking purposes of the water of the pond called Chinna Kolam about two chains square and built with stones, is admitted. It is situated about two chains south-east of the south-east corner of survey No. 147 of Panapakkam. Access is by the Local Fund road in item No. I (1).

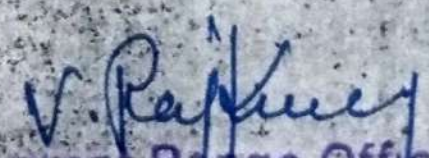
IV. Right to a cart-trag stand close to and north-west of Chinna Kolam about four chains square used by handymen, bullocks and travellers for cooking and other purposes is admitted.
