- c) Remaining 125.85 Ha Forest Land is left as Safety Zone. Out of this Safety Zone Area 80.77 Ha has been diverted vide MoEF letter F.No.8-123/2003-FC dated 8<sup>th</sup> November 2005 (Copy Stage I & Stage II enclosed as Annexure-IV). However, an area measuring 2.63 Ha has been maintained as Safety Zone as per prevailing norms in the year 2005. Hence, it is evident that the 80.77 Ha is a Safety Zone area has already been diverted with the approval of MoEF in November 2005 itself.

If it is a cluster proposal, then the outer boundaries of the cluster should be taken as the safety zone" (Copy enclosed as Annexure VII).

As per the above guideline, 2.63 Ha from 80.77 Ha Forest Land has been maintained as Safety Zone area. As per the above point 'd', 121.58 Ha which is located next to the 80.77 Ha become outer boundary of the project. Due to this cluster of 80.77 Ha & 121.58 Ha Forest land areas, a new Safety Zone area of 3.18 Ha has been allotted by the Forest Department within the outer boundary of the Mining Lease. Hence, the existing Safety Zone Area of 2.63 Ha is not lying at the boundary rather it has come in the
