




### Justification for point No - 6

#### Justification:

Total area for forest diversion is 9.69 ha for Bagru mine. Out of that 7.52 ha is the forest area and 2.17 ha is the safety zone area. Earlier we have applied for Forest diversion of 7.52 ha forest area only excluding safety zone and we have already transferred 7.52 ha CA land to Forest department and the same area of CA land (7.52 ha) has been registered and Mutated in the name of Forest Department earlier. Then we received EDS from PCCF, Nodal office to include safety zone of 2.17 ha also in the diversion proposal as per guideline. Accordingly, we identified CA land for 2.17 ha area for diversion proposal in Mauza Sursang, Dist- Gumla adjacent to the existing forest area. We received Land Suitability certificate, LPC, NEC etc. from different competent Govt. authorities for transferring 2.17 ha CA land to Forest department. This CA land of 2.17 ha has already been registered and mutated in the name of the project proponent (Hindalco). The process for transferring this 2.17 ha CA land to Forest department is in process.

As we need only 2.17 ha CA land for the diversion proposal for safety zone, we have registered and mutated 2.21 ha CA land which is even more than our safety zone diversion area requirement of 2.17 ha.
