Adverting to the references cited on the aforesaid subject matter it is at the outset, informed that the alignment of the project roads are determined on the basis of round geometry and reality by experts. Further, after studied the feasibility and possibility among the options of the project the NHAi has chosen the best alignment finalized and undertaken the work. In the alignment so proposed and finalized the diversion of forest land to an extent of 3.708 Ha in Chinnayampatti Karadu Reserve Forest block, Natham Taluk of Dindigul District is getting involved. The National Highways Authority of India has uploaded the proposal for the diversion of said Forest land in the MoEF, online portal on 28.11.2018.

2. During the process towards the diversion of Forest land the District Forest Officer, Dindigul vide reference 4<sup>th</sup> cited has informed that the diversion of forest

land area is very rich in Bio-diversity including endangered species of Slender Loris and also requested to propose alternative area for formation of road.

3. In this context, the following details are furnished for your kind perusal and to take suitable positive decision,

- The proposed four lane project from Natham - Thuvankurichi section of NH-785E under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase-I Scheme comes under the category of Feeder Route to the Economic Corridor identified by the Government of India, Ministry of Road Transport and Highways. Also, this project is categorized as a High Priority Project by the Government of India.
- Earlier to freeze the alignment this office vide ref 2<sup>nd</sup> cited has requested the DFO, Dindigul to provide the details of Bio Diversity and Flora and Founa. The DFO, Dindigul vide reference 3<sup>rd</sup> cited has infomed that “There is no wildlife Corridors/Tiger/Elephant Crossing in this area” also stated that “No Bio Diversity Importance” in the history of Reserve Forest. Based on that, the DPR consultant of NHAI has freeze the alignment of subject project.
- Presently, the Land acquisition has been completed and 90% of compensation to the land owners has been disbursed. Also, the four lane work has been awarded to the contractor under EPC mode and works have been commenced which are under progress from 28.02.2020. At this advance stage the study of alternative alignment couldn't be possible as it will attract the modification of entire alignment which deviate the contract clause and loss revenue to the government exhiquisher.
- Further, as per EPC agreement the balance land including forest land should be handed over to the contractor within 150 days from the date of commencement of work which is 28.02.2020. Accordingly, the forest

land of 3.708 Ha has to be handed over before 27.07.2020, otherwise the penalty per delayed day shall be payable by the NHA to contractor

- In this regard, it is to be informed that, the NHA assures any mitigation measures proposed by the forest department to protect the endangered animal species of Slender Loris will be considered along with the proposal.

Hence it is requested to consider above details and an early forest recommendation to CCF, Dindigul be expedited for early handing over of the land to the contractor which ultimately help the NHA for early completion of four lane project.



Remarks.—The following rights of way are allowed—

- I. Path from Nallam to Tuvanangurich. It enters the block on the north side of survey No. 1102 of Sirangattipatti close to its north-west corner and running southwards leaves on the south side of survey No. 1210 of the same village. Good wooden chains from the starting point of the northern boundary of the block. It will be six yards wide and open for people, cattle and carts.
- II. Path from Sirangattipatti to Kottaiyur. It enters the block at the north-west corner of survey No. 1102 of Sirangattipatti and running southwards leaves at a point eight chains east of the north-east corner of survey No. 447 of Kottaiyur village. It will be two yards wide and open for people and cattle only.
- III. Path from Sirangattipatti to Walter (Kottaiyur). It branches from path No. II at a point seven and three-fifths chains south-east of the north-east corner of survey No. 447 of Kottaiyur, and running south-eastwards leaves at two chains east of the point of said path No. II. It will be two yards wide and open for people and cattle only.
- IV. Path from Sirangattipatti to Nallur Kottaiyur. It enters the block on the east side of survey No. 447 of Kottaiyur at a point about 1 or 2 chains to the south-east corner of No. 24-B and leaves it on the north side of survey No. 447 of the same village about two chains from its north-west corner. It will be two yards wide and open for people and cattle only.
- V. Path from Sirangattipatti to Nallur Kottaiyur. It enters the block due south of the south-west corner of survey No. 447 of Kottaiyur and running southwards leaves it at a point two chains north of the north-east corner of survey No. 447 of the same village. It will be two yards wide and open for people and cattle only.
- VI. Path to private habitation (survey Nos. 2, 3 and 4 of Sirangattipatti, outside the block). 
