

Land Suitability Certificate for Compensatory Afforestation in lieu of diversion of forest land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for 85 MW Wah Umiam stage-III HEP (Earlier known as Mawphu HEP, Stg-II) in East Khasi Hills District of Meghalaya

The proposed Compensatory Afforestation land is identified in two patches of 8.407 Ha which is continuous to the Nongumiang reserve forest towards South East direction through a donated land of 2.716 ha. The second Plot of 13.603 Ha which is continuous to the Nonumiang reserve forest through compensatory Afforestation land of Lafarge (116.589 Ha) towards North-East direction and other identified compensatory afforestation lands. Further it is certified that the plots identified as above is blank area and is suitable for creation of plantation and management point of view. The aforesaid land is free from encroachment and shall be used for Compensatory Afforestation in lieu of diversion of forest land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for 85 MW Wah Umiam stage-III HEP (Earlier known as Mawphu HEP, Stg-II) in East Khasi Hills District of Meghalaya and not for any other purpose.
