

FIELD INSPECTION NOTES OF THE DISTRICT FOREST OFFICER, SIDDIPET IN RESERVE

FOREST LAND ON 10 .03.2022.

Today I along with the Forest Range Officer, Husnabad and their field staff have inspected the Reserve Forest areas proposed for diversion of 3.3989 Ha. Forest land in RF for rehabilitation and upgradation of Medak-Siddipet-Elukathurthy Section of NH-765 DG Two / Four Lane with paved shoulder (Approximate Length 133.00 Kms) Package-II from Km 69.978 to km 133.650 in the State of Telangana. As detailed below:

The user agency has proposed 3.3989 Ha (1132.970 x 30m) but as per the field verification, it is observed that, only 10 number of peg marks falling within the Shanigaram RF for a length of 368.10m and width varying as mentioned above. Hence the proposed Diverted land arrived to 1.104 Ha. The canopy of these areas is below 0.4 density and as per the enumeration 366 trees / poles are required to be removed from the said area proposed for diversion as mentioned below.

a) 250 trees / poles existing in the forest land of NH-765 DG (M-S-E), Package-II (RHS)

b) 113 trees / poles existing in the forest land of NH-765 DG (M-S-E), Package-II (LHS)





I have searched for other alternatives, but there is no alternative land available except the present proposal. This is the barest minimum area that is required for rehabilitation and upgradation of Medak-Siddipet-Elukathurthy Section of NH-765 DG Two / Four Lane with paved shoulder (Approximate Length 133.00 Kms) Package-II from Km 69.978 to km 133.650 in the State of Telangana i.e., in 1.104 Ha (in a length of 368.10 Mtrs).
