FIELD INSPECTION REPORT ON NON FOREST LAND PROPOSED TO BE HANDED OVER FOR Sy. No. 41 an Extent of 2.685 Ha SITUATED AT ITIKYAL VILLAGE, PEMBI MANDAL, NIRMAL DISTRICT BY THE FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, KHANAPUR ALONG MANDAL REVENUE OFFICER, PEMBI ON 06.01.2022

In compliance to the instructions issued vide PCCF, TS, Hyderabad Ref. No. PCCF Rc.No.10368/2019-FCA- 1, Dated: 27.12.2021 it is submitted that the Compensatory Afforestation lands of 2.685 ha identified in Nirmal District for the proposed diversion for forest land of 2.685 ha for (02) roads projects in Nirmal District of Telangana State under Tribal Welfare Scheme of Executive Engineer Tribal Welfare division is inspected by the undersigned along with Tahsildar and Road Inspector of Pembi Mandal on 06.01.2022. The details are as follows:



The type of soil is generally Rocky patches with morram soil and the land is hilly terrain and is already having tree cover of average 0.4 density. There are no suitable gaps for raising of forest species under any method of plantations (SMM/LI/BHA/ Gap planting) as proposed and detailed in the CA Scheme. Hence the same extent of 2.685 Ha of Forest land in Compt.No.899 of Surjapur beat of Khanapur Section of Khanapur Range is proposed as DFL

The area proposed for the C.A. project is having forest growth/ cover of average 0.4 Canopy density. To improve the existing vegetation in the said NFL the forestry operations like SMC works and formation of water harvesting structures, Chainlink, planting of bamboo along the nalas, erection of Solar operated borewells, firelines, inspection paths, etc., are needed. Protection to this area by chain link fencing and watch and ward is important as the human and biotic pressure in very high.

The Revenue Officials certified that, this land is not assigned land and free from encumbrances and encroachments. However, during the joint inspection it is noticed that the said NFL site is suitable to be taken over by the Forest department in lieu of diversion of forest lands for the road projects by TW division. As it is with good tree cover & adjacent to the existing RF Itikyal. The type of soil generally is Rocky patches with morram soil and the land is gentle slope. Major thrust is required for development of Soil and Moisture retention capacity in the area. To improve the existing vegetation in the said NFL 2.685 Ha in Sy.No. 41 of Merunparupu Village of Itikyal Grampanchayat Pembi Mandal of Khanapur Division, the forestry operations like SMC works and formation of water harvesting structures, Chainlink, planting of bamboo along the nalas, erection of Solar operated borewells, firelines, inspection paths, etc., are proposed. Protection to this area by chain link fencing and watch and ward is important as the area is very adjacent to the Merunparupu hamlet of Itikyal Grampanchyat and the human and biotic pressure in very high.
