Sub: Forest Clearance for Strengthening and Widening to two lane with paved shoulder which starts at Bikramganj – Dawath – Maliyabagh – Nawanagar – Dumraon of NH– 120 (Ch. 201.665 to Ch 240.200) excluding Dawath (Ch. 210.830 to Ch.212.400) & Dumraon bypass (Ch 240.200 to 245.665) in the state of Bihar on EPC mode in Gaya district in the state of Bihar. From <u>Bikramganj – Maliyabag (Km 201+665 to Km 219 +265 (Dist. Rohtas) and Maliyabag – Dumraon bypass Km 219+265 to Km 240+200 (Dist. Buxar).</u>

Sir,

With reference to the above subject, the subject route NH (National Highway-120) by NH-Division, Gaya for preparation of Detailed Project Report (DPR). We are seeking forest clearance for the project which starts at Bikramganj – Dawath – Maliyabagh – Nawanagar – Dumraon of NH– 120 (Ch. 201.665 to Ch 240.200) excluding Dawath (Ch. 210.830 to Ch.212.400) & Dumraon bypass (Ch 240.200 to 245.665) in the state of Bihar.

In the initial survey it is ascertained that this stretch comes under the Notified Protected forest passes through viz. starts Km Ch. 201.665 at Bikramganj, Naranpur, Dawath, Maliyabagh & Kawai, Rupaspur, Navanagar, Basudewa, Athar Arazi, Koran Sarai, Dumraon and ends at Km Ch. 240+200. With respect to this we, have decided to Concentric Up-gradation Widening and strengthening work of existing Two Laning with paved shoulder of stretch from Bikramganj – Dawath – Maliyabagh – Nawanagar – Dumraon of NH– 120 (Ch. 201.665 to Ch 245.665) excluding Dawath (Ch. 210.830 to Ch.212.400) & Dumraon bypass (Ch 240.200 to 245.665) in the state of Bihar.

In this proposed alignment, 40.01 ha. Forest land (Dist. Rohtas-18.87 Ha. + Dist. Buxar-22.14 Ha. = 41.01 Ha.) will be affected in the Notified Protected Forest and approx. 2059 no. trees are likely to be fallen (From Bikramganj – Maliyabag = 1174 trees (Dist. Rohtas) and Maliyabag – Dumraon bypass = 785 trees (Dist. Buxar)

It is requested to do the needful for granting forest clearance.
