

No. G. 12812—Ft. 35-30-128, dated 30th June 1931.

The Government of His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore are pleased to declare under the provisions of Section 35 of the Mysore Forest Regulation, that the land, the limits of which are described in the schedule annexed hereto, shall be constituted a minor forest under the name Hebari minor forest for the purposes of the rules for the management of the Minor Forests issued with Government Notification No. G. 12683—Ft. 185-24-8, dated the 11th April 1929.

Boundaries.

North.—Starting from the junction gadi bandh of Battalpalli and Barlapalli villages the line runs east along the southern boundary of Barlapalli village to the junction gadi bandh of Barlapalli and Marinayanpalli villages; then south-east along the western boundary of Marinayanpalli to the junction gadi bandh of Marinayanpalli and Dondapalya villages; then south-east east and south-west along the western boundary of latter village to the junction gadi bandh of Dondapalya and Jodi Inam Alavatta villages.

East.—Then west along the northern boundary of Survey Nos. 111 and 110 of Hebari to the north-west corner of latter Survey No; then north along the eastern boundary of Survey No. 118 to its north-east corner; then south-west along its northern boundary to its north-west corner; then south along its western boundary to its south-west corner; then south-east along its southern boundary to its south-east corner; then crossing the road runs north east along Bangalore-Cuddapah Road till it meets the west limit of Jodi Inam Alavatta village; then south-west along the western boundary of Jodi Inam Alavatta village to the north-east corner of Dodarjenahalli village.

South.—Then west along the northern boundary of Dodarjenahalli village to the junction gadi bandh of Dodarjenahalli and Ainaraddipalli villages.

West.—Then north-east and west along the eastern and northern boundary of Survey No. 44 of latter village to its north-west corner; then north-east along Bangalore-Cuddapah Road for about 20 chains and then crossing the road meets the north-east corner of Survey No. 121 of Hebari village; then north-west along the northern boundary of Survey Nos. 121 and 120 of Hebari to the north-west corner of latter Survey No. then north-west along the eastern boundary of Survey No. 82 to its north-east corner; then north-west along the boundary to the south-east corner of Survey No. 84; then north along its eastern boundary to its north-east corner; then west along the northern boundary of Survey Nos. 84 and 80 to the north-west corner of Survey No. 86 of Hebari; then north-east along the eastern boundary of Battalpalli till it meets the starting point.

The rights and privileges allowed to be enjoyed by the villagers within the Block:—

(A) *Right of way:—*

1. Barlapalli-Hebari cart-track,
2. Cart track from Barlapalli to Bangalore-Cuddapah Road.

(B) *Right of pasture:—*

The villagers of Hebari village are entitled to graze their cattle (except goats) within the block on payment of lumpsum grazing fees.
