

Compliance to the observations made by Principal Chief Conservator of Forests Bangalore vide is letter No. KFO/HOFI/AS-4 (GFC)-47/2019-FC,

Dated:-16/04/2020.

Replies in Respect of Srinivasapur Taluk – K-ship- Project-Concerned Villages as per J.M.C.

1) As per Para (1) d- the proposed road passes through Sy No. 55 of Yandagunttapalli village in Srinivasapur Taluk an extent of 0-03 Guntas of land is acquired for Road development under Kship-3 project. (Package-1B).

This portion of an extant of 0-03 guntas in Sy No. 55 of Yandagunttapalli Village is proposed for acquired under J.M.C.

The proposed Road is also passes through the Sy No. 15 of Yandagunttapalli Village an extent of 00-22-12 Guntas of land is covered for the Kship-3 project (Package-1B) is coming under minor Forest area.



Hence this area of land an extant of 00-22-12 Guntas at Sy No. 15 of Yandagunttapalli Village Srinivasapur Taluk is to be considered ^{under} Minor Forest Area.

2) In respect of Mandyala Village, Sy No. 159 an extent of Forest land is 00-17-08 Guntas is covered as per the Measurement made according to survey records and also the proposed Road 1-B of Kship-3 is running through the Sy No 159 of Mandyala Forest lands.

As remarked in the Para 1-(D) the Sy No 157 of Mandyala Village in Srinivasapur Taluk is far away from the proposed K-ship-3 (Package-1B) Road.

Hence the land in Sy No. 157 of Mandyala Village is not proposed for land acquisition for Road construction this is wrongly indicated in DPR.

Hence the acquisition of land in Sy No. 157 of Mandyala Village, does not arise. And Sy No. 159 of Mandyala Village is considered for acquisition.
