

Detailed note on the project

It is observed that there are good quantities of deposits for extraction of Crushed metal stone materials in order to cater the needs of constructions taken up by the Government projects and the private parties in the vicinity and their details are as follows.

- 1) The State Government has planned to construct good number of house
- 2) Expansion of State Roads about 10 Kms distance
- 3) Expansion of NH 18 four lines road Kurnool to Nandyal
- 4) There is a lot of construction activities of large number of houses
- 5) Formation of feeder canals and channels, by the Irrigation Department

It is submitted that there is acute shortage of raw materials like crushed stones and boulders in the RCC constructions of the above projects as the construction activities are under progress. There projects are requiring huge quantities of raw materials like crushed metal stone and boulders. The projects are mainly dependent on such raw materials which are abundantly available in the area.

It is proposed to extract the deposits, in an effective manner, with machinery and other sophisticated methods to cater to the needs for heavy construction activities. The present operations are not keeping pace with the demand resulting bottle necks in the construction activities of Government in particulars and private construction in general. The projects ensures not only environmental protection by raising forest species in other alternative areas and also generate employment to the local youth and weaker sections of people
