


The land of area is falling vacant for the construction of above training centre The Hon'ble Chief Minister has also desired to open this revenue training facilities but also awareness to the people of the area.

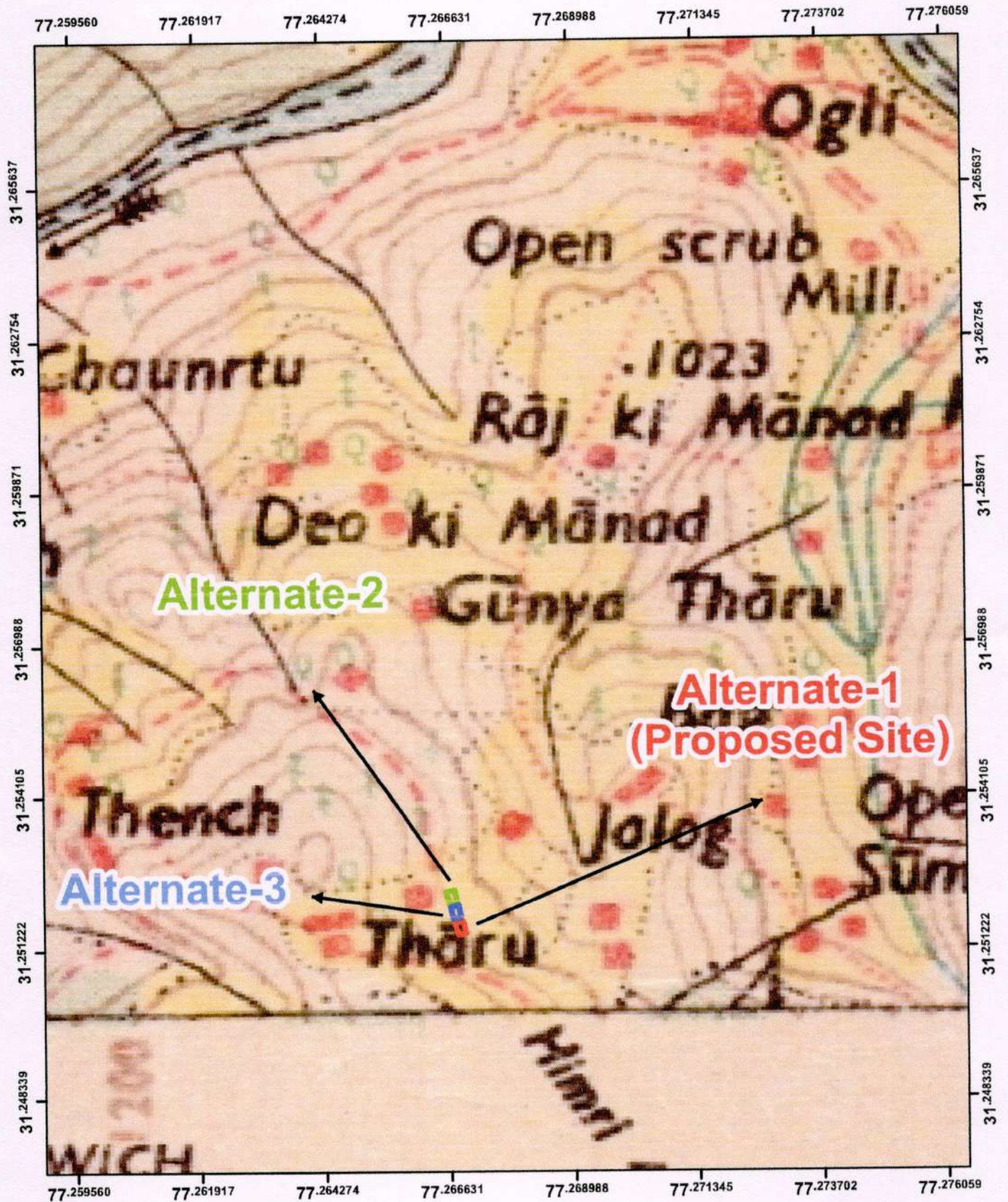

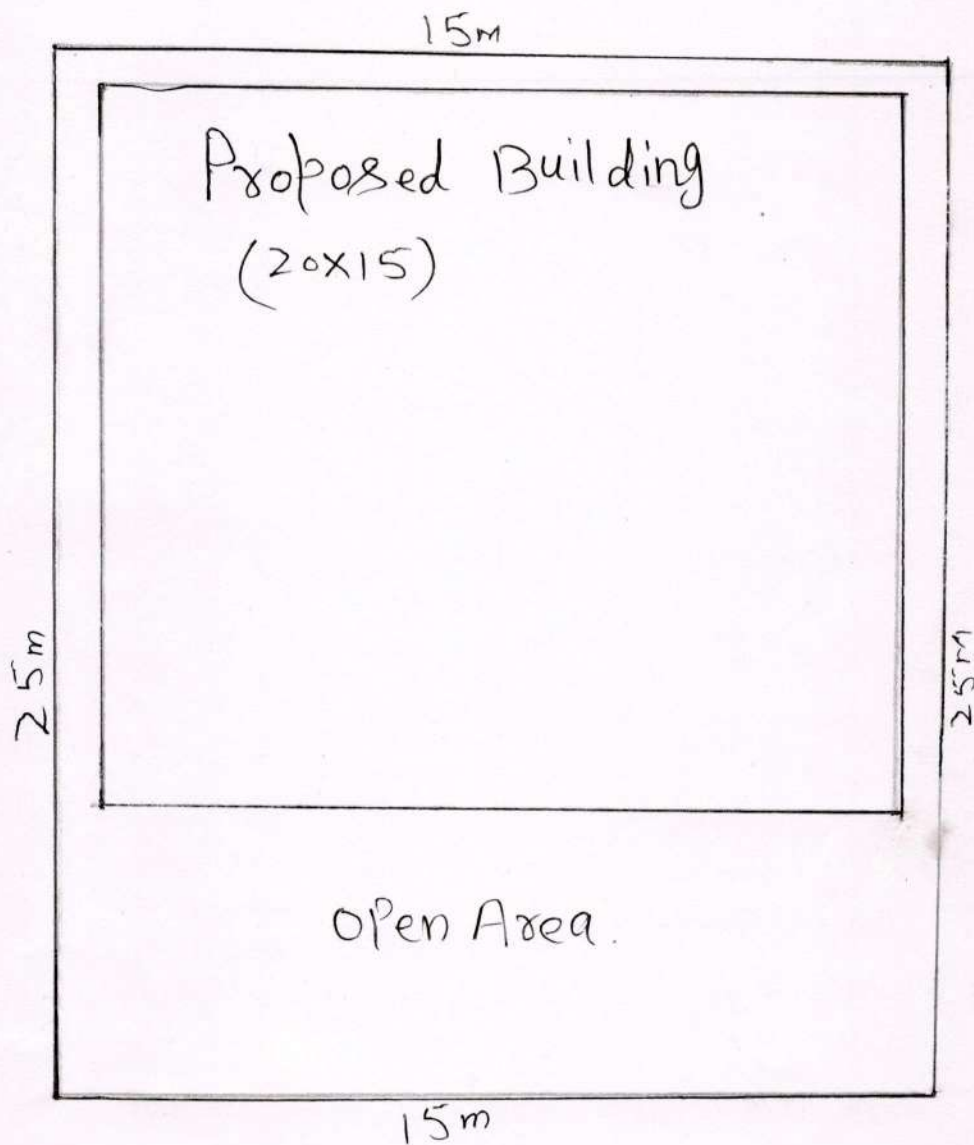
Digital Landuse Map for C/o Revenue Training Center at Jalog, Sub-Tehsil Jalog District Shimla HP
