In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's No. 11-9/98-FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA' for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects it is certified that **0.052** hectares Revenue forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of "Sub Divisional Engineer, Telecom Project Raipur(C.G.)" for the laying Optical fiber cable in Bastar district falls within jurisdiction of Bhanpuri village in Bastar teshil.
