The proposal in question has be-a examined by the Central Government under Section 2 of the For∈st (Conservation) Act 1280 in details. After careful examination of the proposal, the Central Government conveys it sapproval for diversion of 1.6≥ ha forest land for exploratory drilling for locating oil reserves in location Suphayon - 1 in Dayang R.F. Jolayhold loved Divin Assam. on the following conditions.

1. Legal status of the forest land shall remain unchanged.

2. User agency shall pay the cost of -tompensatory afforestation to

the State Government in Forest Department.

3. Compensatory afforestation in degraded forest land over double the area diverted, subject to submission of a certificate regarding non-availability of non-sprest land duly signed by the 'Chief Secretary to the Government of Assam. Unless this certificate is sent to this offic and kept in files at levels, the forest land so diverte shall not be handed over.

4. Exploration shall commence and complete under the overa. supervision of the Divisional Forest Officer of the area.

5. The forest area so used shall be reclaimed by restoring it to original condition with suitable afforestation. A reclamation plan of restoration and afforestation shall prepared by the Divisional Forest Officer in consultation with the user agency and a copy shall be submitted to this office

The State Government shall only handover the land to user agency after complying with the conditions No. 1, 2 & 3 above.
