Please find enclosed herewith detailed pointwise compliance for EDS raised vide File No.8-48/2008-FC-(Vol) dated 17.04.2023 in respect of Proposal for diversion of 431.59 Ha Forest Land of Amrapali Project, Amrapali-Chandragupia Area, CCL:-

1.	The State Government shall provide present status of the offence report issued by the State Forest Department against erring officials for violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 by the user Agency.	No New Roads have been constructed in proposed area for diversion by the project proponent which can be seen through comparative KML of 2012 & 2022. The screenshot of KML of 2012 and 2022 along with Latitude and Longitude are attached as Annexure I for comparison purpose. Further the part of the road for which forest offence has been registered (as mentioned by DFO Chatra South on compliance to EDS of MoEF&CC Delhi raised on 05.07.2022), is of no use for project proponent. In this regard a self-certified declaration has been given and attached as Annexure-XV.
	The State Government has informed that proposal for 13.70 Ha of Forest land for construction of Honhe-Saradhu road has been withdrawn by the user agency. In the	Honhe-Saradhu Road was planned for Coal Transportation from Amrapali opencast to Phulbasia siding and Piparwar CHP. Accordingly, a proposal for diversion of 13.70 Ha (for Honhe-Saradhu Road) forest land was applied vide ref no: - FP/JH/Road/34877/2018 dated 21.07.2018.

withdrawal letter user agency has mentioned that the proposal for diversion of 13.70 Ha is a part of instant proposal i.e., 431.59 Ha, whereas State Government has informed that only 1.05 Ha out of 13.70 Ha has been included in the instant proposal, which is contradictory and needs to be clarified.

The Village wise and S.O. (Statutory Order of Land acquired under CBA Act) wise details of 13.70 Ha forest land is given below: -

Meanwhile, NTPC had established a road for facilitating the under-construction Tandwa power plant bypassing Tandwa market/ town. CCL started using this road for coal transportation from Amrapali to Phulbasia Siding and Piparwar CHP. Therefore, there was no requirement of Honhe-Saradu Road. With this development, the proposal of 13.70 Ha as mentioned in pre-pa was withdrawn.

From the KML file of above 13.70 Ha land, it is found that out of 13.70 Ha, only 2.60 Ha land is included in the instant proposal of 431.59 Ha and 1.00 Ha land is part of already released 531.64 Ha forest land (2.60 + 1.00 = 3.60 Ha. Refer S.O. No: 1381 in the table above). The 2.60 Ha land is a subset of 13.70Ha (i.e., earlier proposed Honhe-Saradhu road, now withdrawn) as well as 431.59Ha (i.e. Instant proposal of Amrapali OCP).

Balance 10.10 Ha land {(13.70-2.60-1.0)=10.10 Ha Land} is not included in the instant proposal.

III.

The State Government informed that FRA, 2006 compliance certificate issued by DC Chatra for 651.16 ha. of forest land is for 04 (four) different projects including the area of 431.59 ha. of forest land. However, bifurcation of 651.16 ha of forest land as provided by the State Government is not mentioned in FRA certificate. The State Govt. shall ensure that the area involved in the instant proposal is actually covered under the certificate ibid.

Combined FRA certificate in respect of the proposals of Magadh and Amrapali Coal projects and NBCC road of CCL was issued for 651.16 Ha wherein the entire plotwise area of Amrapali OCP (431.59 Ha) is included. The difference area of 219.57 Ha (651.16 Ha - 431.59 Ha) is issued for the coal mining project of Magadh OCP and NBCC road. From the Gram Sabha proceedings in respect of village Kumarang Khurd, Binglat, Kumarang Kalan, Ursu and Honhe it is ensured that the area involved in the instant proposal is actually covered under the FRA certificate issued by DC Chatra. (Copy of the Gram Sabha Proceeding enclosed as Annexure: -II).

The safety zone in respect of the forest proposal of 531.64 Ha forest land diverted vide letter no.8-48/2008 FC dated 12.10.2010 was 4.5 Hectare. The 4.5 Ha of forest land that was proposed as safety zone in respect of 531.64 Ha is now included in instant proposal of 431.59 Ha.

Further it is to mention that 7.5 Ha safety zone is proposed in respect of the forest proposal of 431.59 Ha (mentioned in component wise break up in FORM A) which will be maintained as per rule.

DFO Chaura (S) raised a demand note of Rs 55,28,655 for payment of safety zone in 4.5 Ha area vide letter no: - 314 dated 30.01.2023 (Copy attached as Annexure-IV).

In this regard the compliance has been submitted to DFO Chaura South vide Letter

With regard to Safety zone maintained by the user agency, the State Government has informed that the proposed area covered under the instant proposal, not being maintained properly as in anticipation of acceptance of this proposal. Maintenance of the safety zone is an essential condition. The justification for neither complying with it nor seeking its relaxation shall be submitted. The details of safety zone maintained in lieu of diversion of 531.64 ha and activities viz plantation, ANR and afforestation over 1.5 times the area of safety zone shall be submitted.

V1. The State Government informed that the user agency has to deposit the amount of NPV for many safety zone areas involved in different projects for which no NPV

amount had been realized earlier. The detail of all such areas along with updated status of NPV payment shall be submitted.

As such from the above it is clear that the NPV of entire Forest land falling in Amrapali Project including the 4.5 Ha safety zone of 531.64 Ha which is now a part of 431.59 Ha has already been paid.

Therefor no additional NPV payment against safety zone is due in respect of Amrapali Project.

As per Satellite imagery it is observed that the construction of metalled Road has been completed in majority area of the 13.70 ha forest land proposal submitted earlier by the user agency. Moreover, construction of new Road is going on in the proposed forest land for diversion. This needs clarification

In this regard, a communication (vide no. 924 dated 27.12.2022) by CF Chatra addressed to RCCF Hazaribagh on the compliance points of EIDS raised by MoEF&CC on 05.07.2022 may be referred. The above communication goes on to mention that the widening and strengthening of the old road was done by NBCC against whom a forest offence report has been registered on 15.12.2021. Copy of the offence report is enclosed at **Annexure XII**.

Further it is to mention that, the road in question was in existence even before the commencement of mining operation in the project and was being used by the nearby villagers. To this effect, a communication from Circle Officer, Tandwa (Chatra) vide no. 272 dated 25.02.2023 is attached as **Annexure XIII**.

Other than this, there are approach roads to nearby villages used by the residents of these villages for day to day commute. These village roads were in existence even before the beginning of mining operations. The screenshot of KML of 2012 and 2022 along with Latitude & Longitude are attached as **Annexure I** for comparison purpose.

Moreover, No new Roads have been constructed in proposed area for diversion by the project proponent.

XIII

As per Satellite imagery area of 128 ha additional proposed for CA is having encroachment of Agriculture land, Settlements, Road etc. Moreover, some construction activity is also going on in the Village Kurlonga which is proposed for CA. This needs clarification.

Officers of Integrated Regional Office (IRO) MoEF&CC Ranchi along with DFO, Chatra South inspected the Site proposed for diversion of 431.59 Ha forest land and its CA land on 17-03-2023.

During the inspection, it was found that CA land of village Karo (102.00 Ha) has agriculture land, Road and settlement. Whereas CA land site of Kurlonga village (25.00 Ha) was found suitable. Accordingly, a Fresh 102 Ha of CA Land in Village Jungi (50 Ha) and Changer (52 Ha) against Karo Village (Area 102 Ha) along with its Suitability certificate, KML files, Topo sheet, DGPS MAP and CA Scheme has been proposed vide letter no: - 826 dated 31.03.2023.

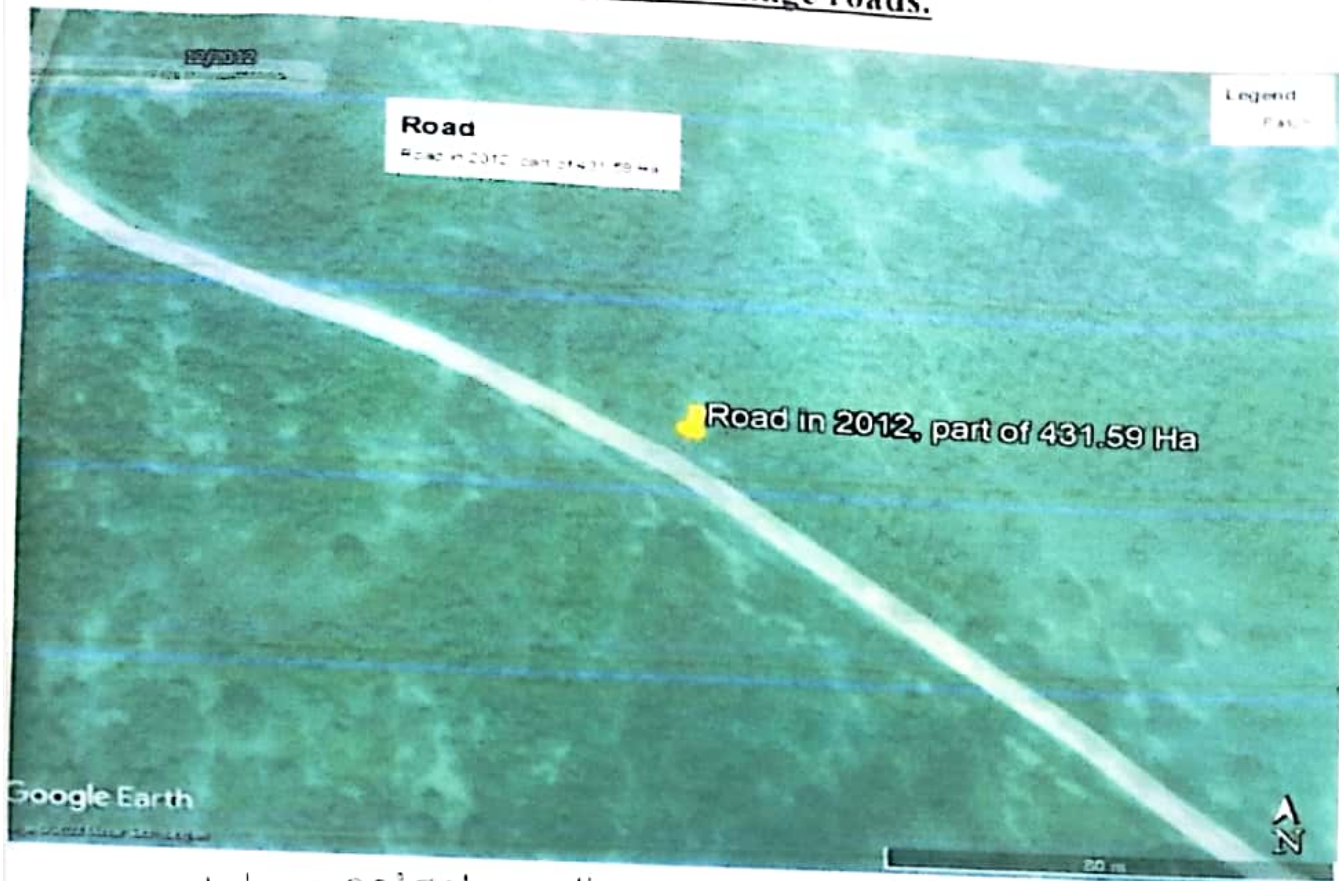

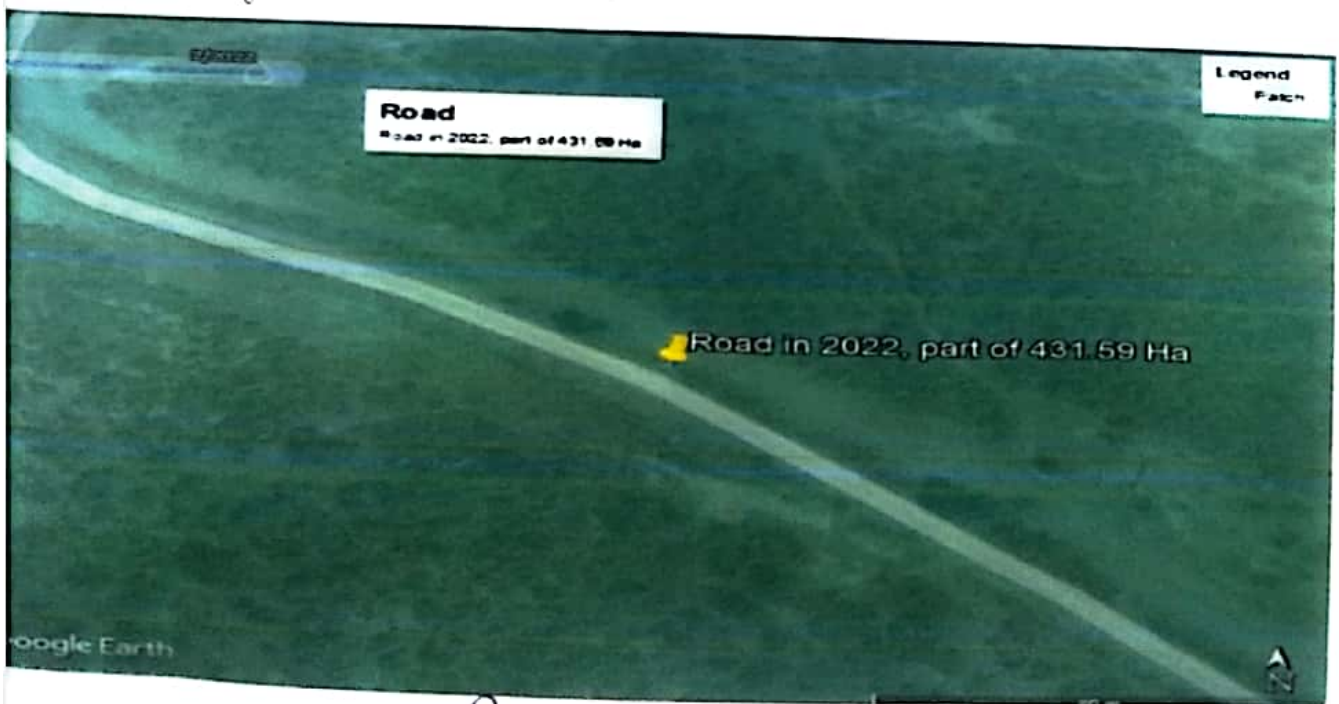

condition of wildlife conservation management plan for 531.64 ha. of diverted forest land should also stipulated and implemented in the interest of wildlife.

4. Analysis of purposed breakup of the area revealed the following:

- An area of 85.09 ha of forest land proposed for infrastructure. Detail of infrastructure activities proposed in the forest land may be informed by the State along with the possibility to shift these activities to non-forest areas of the project.
- Consolidated KML files containing various project components viz. quarry, OBs, road, etc, needs to be submitted.

From the above breakup it is clear that 85.09 Ha Forest land and 21.30 ha non forest land is available for construction of infrastructure as most of the non-forest is being utilized for Quarry Embankment and OB dump, all of which are site specific land use which cannot be shifted to other place, as such there is no other non-forest site which can be utilized for shifting the infrastructure proposed within the proposed area. Apart from this shifting of these infrastructure components will not be economically viable also.

The aforesaid reply of the user agency may be accepted.

(b.) Consolidated KML files containing various project components viz. quarry OBs, road, etc, is being submitted along with the compliance in soft copies.

5. Project specific R&R plan has not been submitted and the copy of R&R Plan uploaded online is not in compatible format; project specific R&R Plan may be uploaded online and submitted to Ministry.

- Agreement executed between CCI & M/s RITES Limited for construction of Amrapali Railway. Copy of award letter is attached as Annexure-V.
- Work for culverts, bridges and railway track are under process in non-forest land. Copy of detailed progress report is attached as Annexure-VI.

The reply submitted by user agency may be accepted.

7. It may be ascertained from the compliance of FRA, 2006 that proposal has been submitted for an area of 431.59 ha while the compliance of FRA, 2006 has been submitted in respect of 651.16 Ha. Discrepancy in the forest area needs to be rectified by the State.

The FRA 2006 compliance certificate issued by DC, Chatra for 651.16 ha. of forest land is for 04 (four) different projects of the user agency the details of which is mentioned here in below-

From the above said facts it is clear that the FRA 2006 compliance certificate issued by DC, Chatra vide his office letter no. 833 dated 10.08.2018 for 651.16 ha. of forest land include the area of 431.59 ha. of forest land also to be diverted by GoI for this mining project.

8. Mining Plan along with Progressive Mine Closure Plan has not been submitted along with the proposal. The same needs to be submitted by the State along with Progressive Mine Closure Plan. State Government may submit its comments on the consistency of the land uses proposed in the Mining plan and in the extant proposal submitted under the FC Act, 1980.

Mining Plan along with progressive mine closure plan has been submitted by the user agency which may be accepted as it is consistent with the land use proposed in the proposal.



No violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 has been reported by the DCF in Part-II and various other authorities in the State. DSS analysis revealed construction of a road in the project area. Further examination of the matter revealed that the said road has been constructed without prior approval of the Central Government under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and a proposal for ex post facto approval has also been submitted by the State. Despite the continuing violation of FC Act, 1980 in the project area, incorrect information indicating no violation of the FC Act, 1980 has been reported in the extant proposal. A justification in this regard may be submitted by the State.

It is true that construction of Honhe (Ammali OCP) to Shivpur railway siding road of 3.00Kms comprising 5.44 ha. GMJ and 2.94 ha. Protected forests is an example of illegal construction, encroachment upon forest land and violation of IFA, 1927 also for which the officials of the user agency i.e. CCL and the transportation company namely NKAS Services Pvt. Ltd. and RKTC have been prosecuted by the DFO under the provision of IFA, 1927. Now Govt vide its letter no. FP/II/ENRCH/150436/2021/533dt.15.09.2022 has granted in principal approval in respect of the illegally constructed road of Honhe to Shivpur and the compliance as obtained by the user agency has been forwarded to higher officials for stage-II/final approval for this project.

In regard of the violation of FC Act, 1980 in respect of the instant proposal it is clarified that the abovesaid encroached area now under regularization by Govt does not fall or included in the instant proposal and therefore no violation of forest (Conservation) Act 1980 was reported by DFO in Part-II.

10. Approval dated 12.10.2010 was granted over an area of 531.64 Ha of forest land by the Ministry in the past for the same project. The following details in respect of said approval may be provided by the State:

- a. Updated status on compliance of conditions stipulated in the approval dated 12.10.2010.
- b. Details of safety zone maintained in lieu of diversion of 531.64 ha and activities viz plantation, ANR and afforestation over 1.5 times the area of safety zone may be confirmed by the State.
- c. Detail of NPV realized from the user agency in lieu of diversion of forest land accorded in the past may be informed by the State.

10(a) The compliance report submitted by the user agency in report of 531.64ha. of forest land diverted to the user agency for mining project vide approval dated 12.10.2010 was examined by the Divisional Forest Officer and site inspection were also done by him on 21.12.2022 in this regard. The compliance submitted by the user agency with comment of Divisional Forest Officer is annexed with this report.
(b) Safety zone area in lieu of diversion of 531.64 ha. have been found to be maintained properly on southern sides of the diverted area while in the northern side although no any violation noticed but as it is continuous with proposed area covered under the instant proposal, not being maintained properly as in anticipation of acceptance of this proposal.

However, the afforestation over 1.5 times of the area of safety zone has been done by the state forest department.

(c) The user agency i.e. M/s CCL has at together 04 (four) area working under the territorial jurisdiction of Chatra South Forest Division and these 04 (four) areas have their different open coal projects and other projects against which NPV has been realized as per the GOI guidelines.



Site Inspection Report by Integrated Regional office (MoEFCC), Ranchi towards FC
Proposal No. FP/JH/MIN/1721/2015.

A proposal of 431.59 Ha forest area diversion towards Amrapali open cast (coal-mining) project has been applied by CCL (Central Coalfields Limited) in Chatra South Forest Division in Chatra District of Jharkhand.

While processing the proposal, ministry (MoEFCC) has requested IRO Ranchi to inspect the area under consideration of diversion and to submit a Site Inspection Report (SIR) as per the provisions of FC Rules. The SIR is expected to include assessment of the status of compliance of conditions stipulated in the approval dated 12.10.2010 granted for an area of 531.64 ha for the same project.

Accordingly, site inspection was done by AIGF of IRO Ranchi on 17 & 18th March 2023.

At the time of site inspection, the following officials were present: -

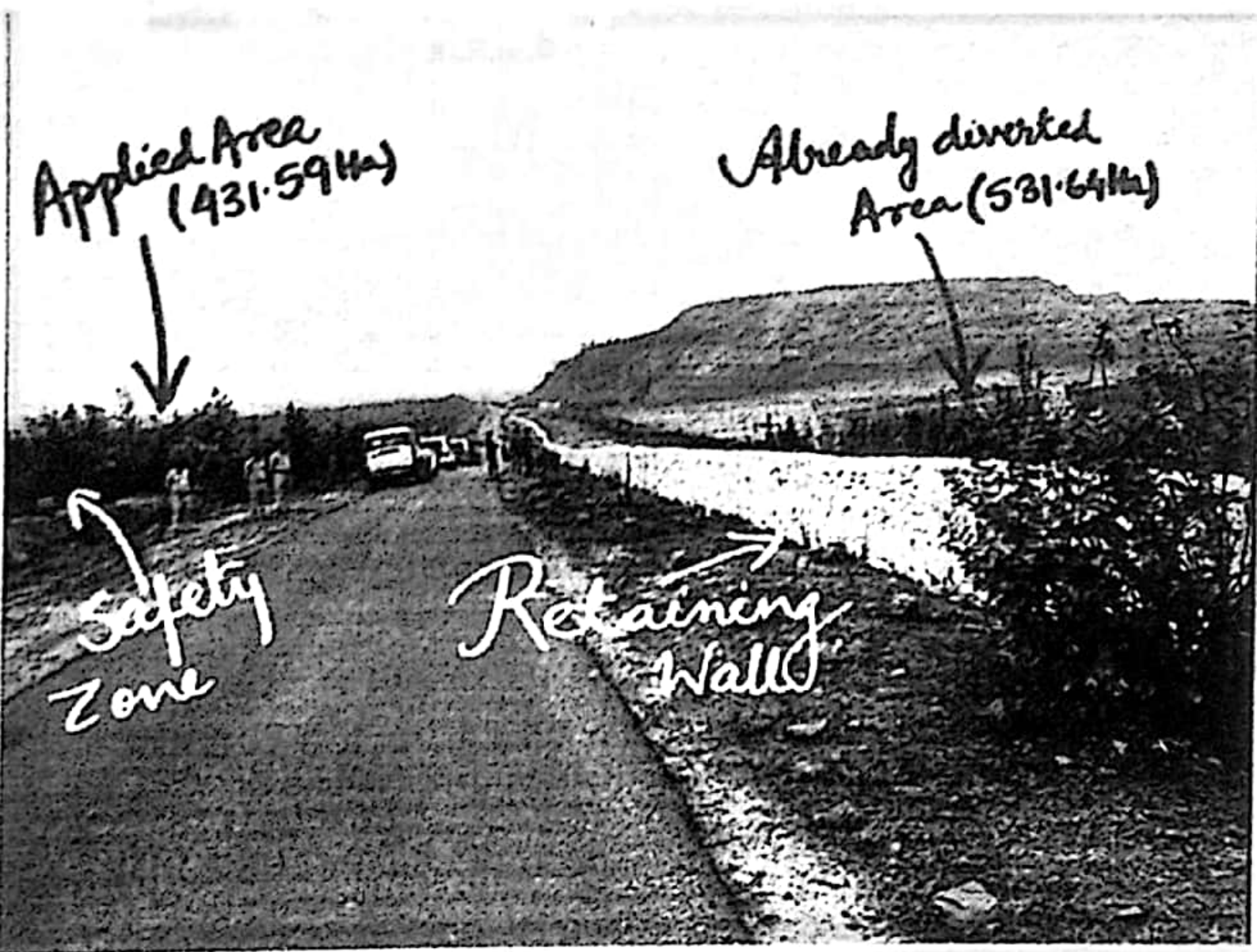

- ❖ Sri P.K. Sinha, DGM Amrapali OCP, CCL

along with their team.

Amrapali OCP is comprised in a total lease area of 1298 Ha. It contains 963.23 Ha of Forest areas as well as 335.75 Ha of non-forest land. In this lease, a forest area of 531.64 Ha has already been diverted for Amrapali OCP to CCL vide ministry's final approval dated 12th Oct 2010. Mining is happening/ongoing in these diverted areas. Final Approval order mentions 22 conditions which user agency/SFD is expected to fulfil during the implementation phase. The complete compliance report was solicited from the project proponent which is attached herewith as Annexure-I. During the field visit it was found that the user agency and SFD have adhered to the stipulated conditions in considerable manner.

Further, the land under the extant application was visited. Applied forest land comprises of Protected Forests as well as GMJJ both. The synoptic of the entire land types involved in the lease are given in the following table:

proposed area was visited extensively during the site inspection visit by government officials and user agency representatives. The proposed area is already diverted area/active mining area but there exist clear demarcated and proposed diversion areas. Such delineation has been done either through fencing and maintaining a safety zone or both as shown below: -



User agency was asked to explain the reasonability of maintaining safety zone at the boundary of active mining area and area which is under consideration of diversion. Representative of user agency apprised that the same is being done in compliance to the condition number 11 of the Final Approval order of the 531.64 Ha area. User agency was further asked to maintain such safety zones at the periphery of lease but within the lease to ensure their utility & perpetuity.

Further since such clear demarcation is in place, user agency has not violated the area proposed for mining. The forest area proposed for diversion is comprised of 335.45 Ha of Protected Forest & 96.14 Ha of GMJJ under administrative jurisdiction of State Forest Department and State Revenue Department respectively.

The forest area under consideration shows varying amount of vegetation density. Few blank patches were observed whereas few areas were found to support good vegetation index. An average of 0.5 Canopy density for the entire area was ocularly estimated State Forest Department Staff apprised that 21620 no. of trees are enumerated in the proposed area but considerable time has lapsed since the counting as counting was done in year 2016-17. The area was characterised by gregarious flowering of Palas trees.

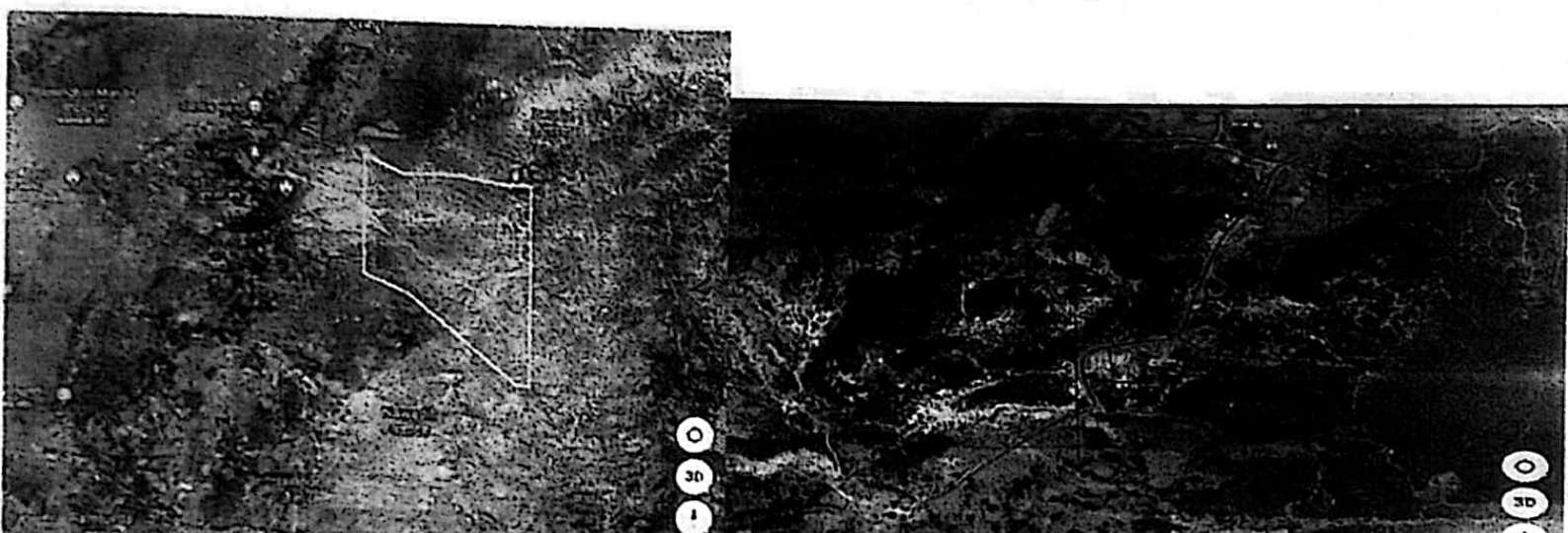
