1.	Rationalization of roads as per inspection report of DFO Billawar	Undersigned alongwith Worthy Superintending Engineer, PMGSY , Jammu circle, Jammu and field staff inspected the road on 05 th of March, 2021 and curtailed the length of road from 18.433 Kms to 12.975 Kms , in order to save the pristine Deodar trees keeping in view the the recommendations of DFO Billawar.
2.	Alternate Route MAP examined by User Agency to be finished to established inescapability of the final Route recommended by the UT Government.	The route recommended by the User agency is shortest, Economical and involves less number of trees. As the topography of the area is very tough, there is no alternate route for the above said road upto 12.975 Kms.
