MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF STATE LEVEL STANDING COMMITTEE OF STATE BOARD FOR WILDLIFE

held on 28th February 2022

An online meeting of the State Level Standing Committee (SLSC) of State Board for Wildlife (SBWL) was held under the Chairmanship of Shri U. M. Sahai on 28th February 2022 at 03:30 P.M. The following members attended the meeting through video conferencing:

- 1. Shri Ishak Ahmed Mughal, Member
- 2. Dr Satish Sharma, Member
- 3. Dr Hem Singh Gehlot, Member
- 4. Shri Daulat Singh Shaktawat, Member
- 5. Shri Arindam Tomar, Chief Wildlife Warden (CWLW), Member Secretary.

The following persons also attended the meeting as stake holders:

- 1. Shri Mahendra Sharma, DCF (Wildlife) & Deputy Field Director, Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve I, Sawaimadhopur
- 2. Shri Bhola Ram, Executive Engineer, Water Resource Department Division, Sikar
- 3. Shri Vijay Prakash, Representative of Rama Minerals M.L. No. 09/03

Dr D N Pandey PCCF (HoFF) could not attend the meeting as he was engaged elsewhere. Shri Jaisal Singh could also not attend the meeting and sent his views on roposals and other issues by email.

The Chairman welcomed the members to the 6th meeting of the Committee. The following decisions were taken:

- (1) Three proposals for Wildlife Clearance were presented before the Committee. The details of the proposals were provided to the committee members beforehand and after discussion, decisions were taken as under:
 - 1. Proposal No. FP/RJ/MIN/4863/2020: Silica Sand Mine M.L. No. 09/03 submitted by M/S. Rama Minerals, Village - Manoharpura, Karauli,

Rajasthan. The project is within the 10 Km Eco Sensitive Zone of Kaila Devi Wildlife Sanctuary and Ranthambore Tiger Reserve. Total project area: 4.2682 ha.

Decision of SLSC- After discussion, the proposal was recommended to be placed for approval in State Board for Wildlife with the conditions as prescribed by Chief Wildlife Warden Rajasthan.

2. Proposal No. FP/RJ/IRRIG/47910/2020: Proposal for Construction of Mansa Mata Anicut, village Kho, G.P. Manaksas, Tehsil Udaipurwati, District Jhunjhunu submitted by Executive Engineer, Water Resources Department Division, Sikar. Total project area: 11.473 ha.

Decision of SLSC- After discussion, the proposal was recommended to be placed for approval in State Board for Wildlife with the conditions as prescribed by Chief Wildlife Warden Rajasthan.

3 Proposal No. FP/RJ/Others/150412/2021: Proposal for construction of Entrance Gate for Ranthambhore National Tiger Reserve Park at Ganesh Dham Sawaimadhopur submitted by DCF (Wildlife) & Deputy Field Director, Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve I, Sawaimadhopur. Total project area: 0.0067 ha.

Shri Mahendra Sharma DCF, Ranthambhore Tiger Reserve I, Sawaimadhopur, Rajasthan gave a power point presentation of the project.

Decision of SLSC- After discussion, it was decided that the entrance gate may be constructed after removal of existing gate and no new land should be used for this purpose. Accordingly, the design may be finalized. The DPR may be submitted along with design and 3D view as well as a presentation by PWD to all the committee members for approval through circulation.

(2) Action Taken Report of State Board for Wildlife meeting dated 15.07.2021 was circulated beforehand to all the committee members and was presented by Chief

प्रोठी कुमार हुन् स्थान क्षेत्रमार हुन् स्थान संस्थान Wildlife Warden, Rajasthan. The discussion covered the issues raised by Shri Jaisal Singh and other members. The following decisions were taken:

- 1. After discussion about the mandate of the Committee, it was decided that the stake holders who have not complied with the decisions taken in the meeting of State Board for Wildlife on 15.07.2021 may be called in the next meeting.
- 2. A corridor map should be prepared for all Tiger Reserves and potential tiger areas.
- 3. A comprehensive rescue plan for wildlife may be developed for Jodhpur circle in view of the heavy demand for rescue of wild animals in that area. This may then be presented to the Government for implementation.

4. Priority should also be given to research and conservation activities of wildlife other than tiger, leopard, Great Indian Bustard, etc.

5. Matters which are subjudice may not be considered by the committee as this may be construed as interference in the proceedings of the Hon'ble Court and contempt. Reference was made to DB(CW) 7567/2021 Chandrabhal Singh vs GoR and others; and DB(CW) 3992/2021 Suo moto vs GoR and others in this regard.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
