Mitigative measures to be taken up in forest area proposed for **1.8584 Ha** of Forest land for Laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road within the existing Right of way for execution of T- Fiber Project in favour of M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited in Kagaznagar Forest Division under Komarambheem District.

1. INTRODUCTION :

The total geographical area of Telangana State is 114840 Sq KM and the total forest area is 28809.08 Sq. Kms. which constitute to 25.19%, whereas the total geographical area of the Kagaznagar Division is 2,85,304 Ha covering the forest area of 1,53,810.54 Ha in (5) Ranges constituting about 53.91 %.

The Kagaznagar Division consisting of (5) Ranges, namely - (1) Sirpur, (2) Karjelly, (3) Kagaznagar, (4) Bejjur and (5) Penchikalpet Ranges.

The Forest area in the Ranges are being utilized as the "Tiger Corridor of Kawal Tiger Reserve" for attracting the Tigers from Thadoba Tiger Reserve of Maharashtra State and Indravathi Tiger Reserve of Chattisgarh State.

In the above scenario the M/s Telangana Fiber Grid Corporation Limited, Begumpet, Hyderabad submitted proposals for Laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road within the existing Right of way for execution of T- Fiber Project. The proposed proposals are falling in Sirpur, Karjelly, Kagaznagar, Bejjur and Penchikalpet Ranges of Kagaznagar Division. The details are shown below:

It is falling in Wildlife area and it is necessary to take up the mitigative measures to counter the consequential problems, in order to protect the flora and fauna.

The Following are the Consequential problems of Laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road in Forest area:

- 1) Biotic interference.
- 2) Depletion of Forest Flora.
- 3) Poaching of Wild Fauna.
- 4) Forest Fires.
- 5) Encroachments
- 6) Soil Erosion.

4. Period of the Scheme:

The Conservation plan period is proposed for 1 year.

5. Objectives:

1. Protection and improvement of the eco-system through mitigative measures.
2. Improvement of water resources through Soil & Moisture Conservation measures by catchment area treatment on watershed principles.
3. Habitat improvement through improvement of fodder availability and protection from fire.
4. Publicity and awareness - conservation education to the stakeholders for protecting Flora and Fauna.

Therefore it is mandatory for addressing the problems expected consequential for **Laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road within the existing Right of way for execution of T- Fiber Project** in Wildlife area in order to achieve the objectives the operations of Gap plantations and SMC works are proposed to improve the vegetation status in the area. Since it is a wildlife area, the wildlife protection and habitat improvement works like fodder development, fire protection and publicity are proposed.

The item of works, quantity and amount required are submitted hereunder:

6. Mitigative plan :

Proposed mitigative measures for Diversion of forest land for Laying of Optical Fiber Cable along the road within the existing Right of way for execution of T-Fiber Project of in Sirpur, Karjelly, Kagaznagar, Bejjur and Penchikalpet Ranges of Kagaznagar Division.

(Project Cost: Rs.86.20 Lakhs x 15% = Rs.12.94 Lakhs).

a cart track and it passes through the village Kataypally. Then it proceeds upto North Eastern corner and reaches a cart track. From here it goes along the cart track in the northwards and it reaches village Kataypally. From here in the east of the village, it crosses two cart tracks and proceeds in zig zag manner in west and north and reaches river of village Kariyally and crosses a cart track at a distance and again turns to west and crosses a cart track while going along the road. Then it proceeds to North east in zig zag manner and enters river of Korani and crosses the cart track and includes S.No. 16, 22, of the above village in the reserve and finally reaches at the starting point 'A'.

BOUNDARY ENCLOSURE NO.1 SIVAPALM

North A-B:- The enclosure line starts from the north eastern point and proceeds straight to a foot path and crosses it and proceeds upto three furlongs 12 chains and reaches point 'B'.

East B-C:- It goes to south east for three furlongs 8 chains till it reaches a cart track running from Gudum and then it goes to east for one furlong 4 chains and reaches point 'C'.

South C-D:- It proceeds to south west for two furlongs and to west for one furlong and to south west for one furlong and 4 chains distance and reaches cart track Sladder and goes for two furlongs 10 chains point 'D'.

West D-A:- From here it proceeds toward north west for three furlongs and in north runs for two furlongs 8 chains and finally reaches the starting point 'A'.

BOUNDARY ENCLOSURE NO.2 CHITTAM

North A-B:- The boundary of the enclosure Chittam village starts in the north west corner S.No. 39 is shown in the map, and proceeds towards north east excluding S.No. 39 and 42 then reaches at the bank of river Pranhita point 'B'.

East B-C:- The line deviates towards south east along the bank of river Pranhita excluding S.No. 22, 24, 21 and 22 then reaches at point 'C'.

South C-D:- From here the line takes a sharp turn towards west and proceeds straight excluding S.No. 3/2, 12, 21 and reaches at the point 'D'.

West D-A:- From here the line proceeds towards north west excluding an area of six aas. for the re-modelling of the present village, then it proceeds towards north straight excluding S.No. 20 and reaches the starting point 'A'.

3. The following cases enquired:-

(i) Decided to exclude patta lands S.No. 81 to 8130 aas. 23 guntas of Buckish, Binda lying on the boundary of the reserve.

(ii) Decided to include patta lands of Mehra Sanasi in Anjani village S.No. 79/1/ 9 aas. in the reserve and compensation of 9 aas. given from paramboke No. 261 in Bijjur village.

(iii) Decided to close the case S.No. 76 of Mohammed Ali in Ambaghat village due to outside the reserve.

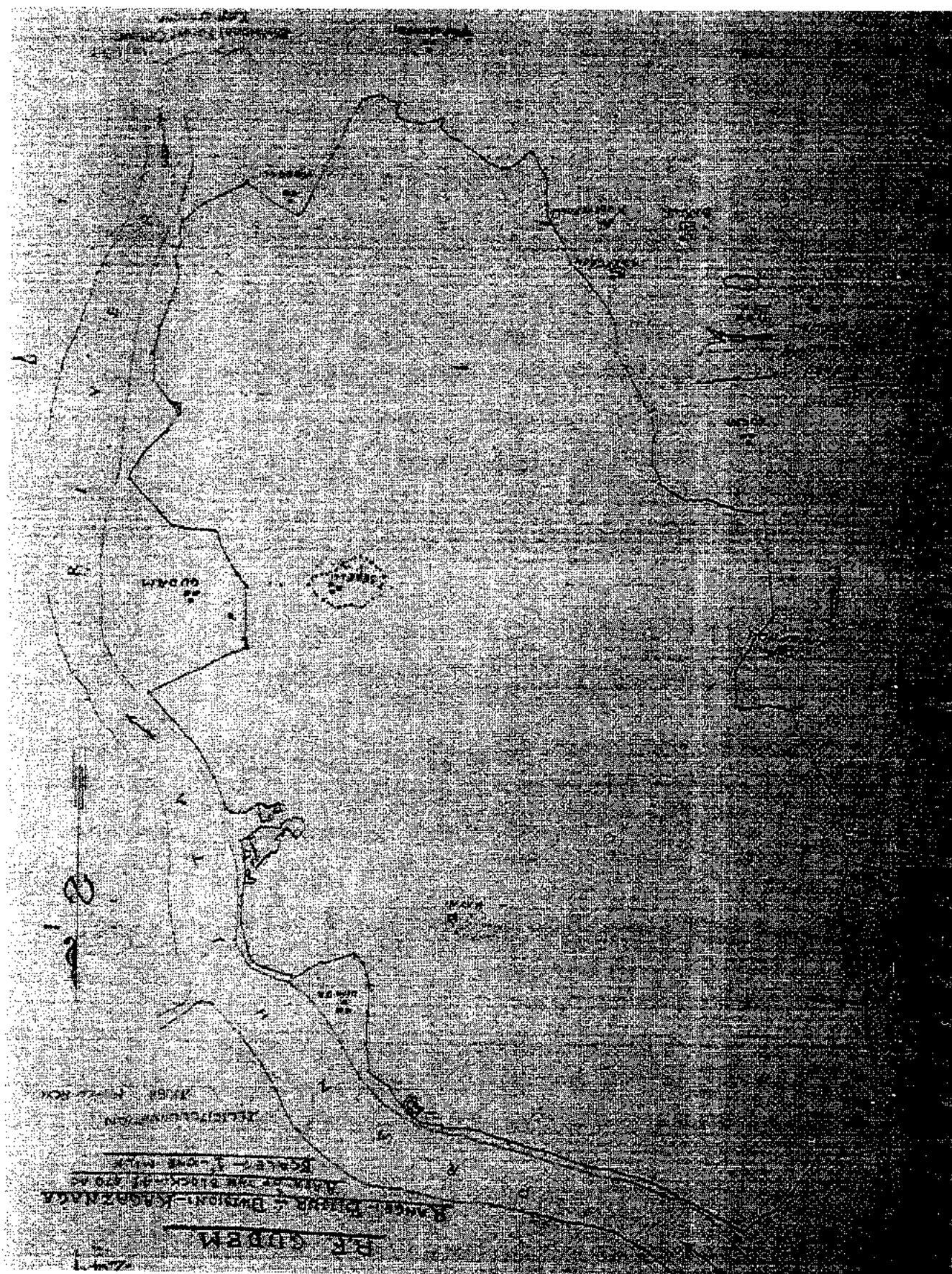
