With reference to your above referred letter, reply of Para no. (i) to (vi) of the observations of MoEF&CC, New Delhi is submitted as under:

No.	The State Government has now submitted the KML file of the mining lease boundary covering an area of 1756.77 ha. In the said kml file it has been found that the user agency has excluded or not applied for the diversion of 24.186 ha forest land. This 24.186 ha forest patch is adjacent to RF-276 (11 ha) which has been proposed for excavation work. The justification for keeping the 24 ha area within the mining lease out of diversion proposal and the proposed measures for the protection of the same shall be submitted.	The proposal for diversion of 631.39 Ha Forest land submitted earlier was rejected by MoEF&CC. Subsequently revised mining plan was prepared considering the revised requirement of Forest land of 139.86 Ha for which the present proposal has been submitted. The requirement of forest land for excavation has been revised to bare minimum by excluding 24.186 Ha which was considered earlier for excavation. This 24.186 Ha forest land will be proposed for diversion if required for expansion of the Project in future (for Phase II excavation).
		For safety and protection of above 24.186 Ha forest land patch from mining activity, safety zone of 2.09 Ha area (out of 18.08 Ha) has been considered in adjacent forest land patch of 11.00 Ha (RF-276) which is part of 139.86 Ha forest land. (KML file enclosed).
