The Government of His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore are pleased to declare, under Section 17 of the Mysore Forest Regulation, XI of 1900, that from the 1st March 1937, the area, the boundaries of which are set forth in the Schedule appended to this Notification, shall be deemed to be a "State Forest" subject to the exercise of rights specified at foot thereof.

Boundaries.

North.—Starting from the north-east corner of Survey No. 65 of Kurumakote, the line runs south-east along the southern boundary of Kolikal State Forest for about 95 chains to the south-east corner of the said State Forest; then north-east along the eastern boundary of the said State Forest for about 37 chains to the north-west corner of Survey No. 26 of Yerjenahalli.

East.—Then south-east through Survey No. 25 of Yerjenahalli for about 16 chains to the north-west corner of Survey No. 28; then south along its western boundary for about 11½ chains to its south-west corner; then south-east along the southern boundary of S. Nos. 28 and 30 of Yerjenahalli for about 28 chains to the northernmost corner of latter survey number; then south along the western boundary of Survey No. 23 of Yerjenahalli for about 40 chains to its south-west corner; then east along its southern boundary for about 10 chains to the north-west corner of Survey No. 64 of Gollahalli; then south-west along its western boundary for about 11½ chains to its south-west corner; then south-east along its southern boundary for about 0 chains to its north-east corner; then south-east along the western boundary of Survey No. 63 of Gollahalli for about 37 chains to the north-west corner of Survey No. 58 of Gollahalli.

South.—Then north-west through Survey No. 19 of Gollahalli for about 72 chains and meets the hotte bandh of Survey No. 24 at a point about 11 chains north-east from the north-east corner of Survey No. 27 of Gollahalli; then north-west through Survey Nos. 24 and 25 of the same village for about 20 chains to the northernmost corner of Survey No. 26 of the same village; then north-west through Survey No. 6 of Holatala village for about 58 chains to the south-east corner of Survey No. 65 of Kurumakote.

West.—Then north-west along the eastern boundary of Survey No. 65 of Kurumakote for about 62 chains to the starting point.

(1) Stating that they have no objection in including Survey Nos. 67 and 68 of Kuramakota and Survey No. 6 of Holatal to Soolekal Block. (2) Praying for the grant of permission to remove wood for their agricultural implements (plough places).	Oral and written statements given at the time of settlement.	(1) Survey No. 68 of Kuramakota is a khurab land. The villagers have no right over this area, besides they have enough gomal land. So the said survey number cannot be excluded from the forest. Survey No. 67 is already included in Kolihal State Forest. Hence this may be excluded from this block. As the gomal left for the cattle of Holatal village is quite enough, the portion taken up for the forest in Survey No. 6 cannot be excluded from the forest. (2) The permission prayed for cannot be granted in the case of Kuramakota. Only Survey No. 68 which is khurab is taken and the villagers cannot claim any privileges not previously existing. While in the case of Holatal, only a small portion of gomal Survey No. 6 is taken to the forest leaving out a major portion which can easily supply their wants. It is not desirable to unnecessarily burden the state forest with rights to which the villagers cannot reasonably lay any claims. There is enough gomal in Gollaballi village and so there is no necessity to exclude Survey Nos. 63, 64 and 66 as prayed for by the villagers. Survey No. 23 of Yerpamballi which contains a katto may be excluded from the forest.	Yes, I agree with the District Forest Officer. Survey No. 68 may be reserved for the forest as proposed. The villagers also are agreeable. Survey No. 67 is already included in the Kolihal State Forest. So this may be excluded from the proposed Soolekal Block as suggested by the District Forest Officer. Survey No. 6 of Holatal, the portion of which has been proposed for Soolekal Block may be reserved for the forest, as the Holatal villagers have got enough gomal. The prayer of the Villagers of Kuramakota for permission to remove wood for agricultural implements cannot be granted for reasons put forth by the District Forest Officer vide column 6.

Praying (1) for the exclusion of Survey Nos. 63, 64 and 65 of Gollaballi from the Soolekal Block on the ground that they have got insufficient khurab and gomal lands in their village limits. (2) For the exclusion of Survey No. 23 of Yerpamballi as it contains a katto containing water and to which their cattle go for water.	Do	Survey Nos. 63, 64 and 65 of Gollaballi may be excluded from the forest by affixing the forest line to the village limit as the gomal left is almost rocky and insufficient and there is keen demand for lands for cultivation in khurab and assessed waste lands. Survey No. 23 of Yerpamballi may also be excluded from the forest for the use of the villagers as it contains a katto by name Chirappana katto and the cattle of the adjoining villages go there for water always. Besides this, the villagers have to pass through this katto to go to their individual lands in Survey No. 24 and 26 for cultivation. Hence this has been excluded.

Oral and written statements made at the time of settlement.	This is not possible as the villagers have got enough gomal left for their cattle.	Yes, I agree with the District Forest Officer. The prayer of the villagers is untenable as the gomal left for the village is quite enough.
